8. Repair rear stairs - treads, stringers, risers and railings
9. Reconstruct brick columns and supports in front leaning
10. Repair plaster on ceiling in apartment downstairs (water damage  
and falling)
11. Tuck-point foundation as necessary - seperating  
Garage

Due to the total deterioration of the garage, you are requested  
to demolish it.
