And it appearing that no objections were filed thereto and the Court being fully advised in the premises now finds that:

1. Due notices of the filing of said account and petition and of the hearing on the same were given to all persons interested in said estate, and the same are now properly before the Court for final action thereon.

2. That Chester Mech, died testate, a resident of the County of Lake, State of Indiana, on the 14th day of September, 1985, and his Last Will and Testament was duly admitted to probate before this Court on the 2nd day of October, 1985, and this Court appointed said Dorothy R. Papesh as Executrix of the Last Will and Testament of the decedent, and said Executrix was issued Letters of Testamentary on the 2nd day of October, 1985, to her and since that date she has continued to serve in such capacity.

3. That the matters and things stated in said account and petition are true, and that said Executrix has accounted for all the assets in said estate coming into her hands.

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4. More than five (5) months have elapsed since the date of first published notice to legatees, devisees and creditors of said decedent; all claims filed against said estate have been paid and discharged; neither said decedent nor his Executrix was an employer of labor within the meaning of that term as used in the Indiana Employment Security Act; all estate taxes, inheritance taxes and gross income taxes, if any, assessed in said estate have been paid.

5. The following person is the sole legatee and devisee under the decedent's Last Will and Testament: Dorothy R. Papesh is the sole legatee of all of the assets contained in said estate.

6. That the decedent owned as an asset of the estate the real estate located at 8727 Hohman Avenue, Munster, Indiana, more particularly described as:

and that the decedent devised said real estate in his Last Will and Testament to Dorothy R. Papesh.

7. Attorney fees in the amount of Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$4,500.00) and expenses of Sixty-Two Dollars and Twenty-Five Cents (\$62.25) payable to Singleton, Levy, Crist and Johnson are found and determined to be fair and reasonable.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court as follows:

1. Said Final Report and Account of said Executrix is hereby in all things approved, settled and confirmed.

2. That the distribution of the balance of the property remaining in said Executrix's hands for distribution has been made pursuant to the distribution set forth in the final accounting as prescribed under the Last Will and Testament of said decedent and is hereby in all things approved.

3. That pursuant to the decedent's Last Will and Testament the following described real estate, to-wit:

Lot 15, Block Two, Knickerbocker Manor Third Addition to the Town of Munster, Lake County, Indiana


is hereby vested in Dorothy R. Papesh pursuant to the provisions of the decedent's Last Will and Testament.

4. Said Executrix having made distribution of all assets and property and having attached receipts evidencing said distribution to said legatee, said distribution is hereby approved and confirmed.

5. Said Executrix is ordered to pay Singleton, Levy, Crist and Johnson the sum of Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$4,500.00) as and for attorneys fees for services rendered and to pay said firm the sum of Sixty-Two Dollars and Twenty-Five Cents (\$62.25) for expenses.

6. Said Executrix is hereby released and discharged from any further liability or responsibility as said Executrix of the Estate of Chester Mech and said estate is ordered closed.
