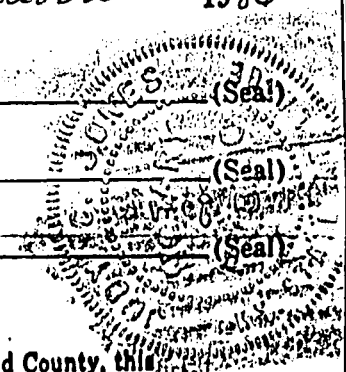

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED AS FOLLOWS:


1. That the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between





This matter coming on for hearing before Hon. Robert C. Manchester, Special Commissioner, McCracken Circuit Court, Division No. II, on February 20, 1985, and it appearing that the Petitioner and the Respondent are properly before the Court, and the Court being sufficiently advised, hereby makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Petitioner is a resident of the Commonwealth of Kentucky and has been a resident of the Commonwealth of Kentucky for more than 180 days next preceding the filing of the Petition for Dissolution of Marriage.
2. The Petitioner and the Respondent were married on December 19, 1965, and the marriage is registered at Gary, Lake County, Indiana.
3. The Petitioner and the Respondent have been separated since September 1, 1982.
4. Petitioner and Respondent are the natural parents

of two children, namely: Lisa M. Orr, born February 24, 1967, age 17 years, and Chandra L. Orr, born April 22, 1977, age 7 years.

5. The infant children of the Petitioner and the Respondent reside with the Petitioner, and the Petitioner is a fit and proper person to have the care, custody and control of the said infant children subject to reasonable visitation rights on the part of the Respondent.

6. The Petitioner is not pregnant.

7. The marriage between the Petitioner and the Respondent is irretrievably broken.

8. The conciliation provisions of KRS Ch. 403.170 do not apply.

9. The Petitioner and Respondent have no marital property.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Court has jurisdiction of the Respondent to this action pursuant to CR 4.06 (Court lacks personal jurisdiction) and Petitioner has the right to enter a supplemental decree pertaining to child support and maintenance some latter date when the Court has personal jurisdiction over Respondent.

2. The Petitioner and the Respondent are entitled to a Decree dissolving their marriage.

3. The marriage between the Petitioner and Respondent is irretrievably broken, and the conciliation provisions of KRS Ch. 403.170 do not apply.

4. The Petitioner shall have the care, custody and control of Lisa M. Orr and Chandra L. Orr, the infant children of the Petitioner and the Respondent. The Respondent shall have the right to reasonable visitation.

5. A Decree of Dissolution of Marriage dissolving the marriage between the parties shall be entered in accordance with these Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.
