2. WILLIAM J. MUHA died testate a resident of Lake County, Indiana, on August 29, 1984, and decedent's Last Will and Testament was duly admitted to probate before this Court on September 18, 1984. This Court then appointed BARBARA N. MUHA executrix of the Last Will and Testament of the decedent, and said personal representative was issued Letters Testamentary on September 18, 1984; she has continued to serve in such capacity since said date.

3. The matters and things stated in said account and petition are true, and said personal representative has accounted for all the assets in said estate coming into her hands.

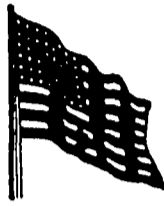
