And it appearing that no objections were filed thereto and the Court being fully advised in the premises, now finds that:

1. Due notices of the filing of said account and petition and of the hearing on the same were given to all persons interested in said estate and the same are now properly before the Court for final action thereon.

2. That William B. Bartok, Jr., died intestate, a resident of the County of Lake, State of Indiana, on the 25th day of September, 1977, and said personal representative was issued Letters of Administration on the 8th day of May, 1987, to her and since that date she has continued to serve in such capacity.

3. That the matters and things stated in said account and petition are true and that said personal representative has accounted for all of the assets in this estate coming into her hands.

4. More than five (5) months have elapsed since the date of the first-published notice to the heirs and creditors of said decedent; all claims filed against said estate have been paid and discharged; neither said decedent nor his personal representative were employers of labor within the meaning of that term as used in the Indiana Employment Security Act; all estate taxes, inheritance taxes and gross income taxes, if any, assessed in said estate have been paid.

1, Janet E. Bartok, wife; Marcia artok, daughter, and Gayle Kaczmark, daughter, and that said decedent died married, leaving no other child or children, nor decendants of any predeceased child or children, other than enumerated above.

6. That the decedent owned a certain piece of real estate located at 8310 Hawthorne Drive, Munster, Indiana 46322, in the County of Lake, State of Indiana, more particularly described as follows:

28-103-2 Lot 2, Block 6, Wicker Park, in the Town of Munster as shown in Plat Book 20, page 40, in Lake County, Indiana.

and that upon the death of said decedent, said real estate vested by the laws of intestacy in Janet E. Bartok, wife, Marcia Bartok, daughter; and Gayle Kaczmark, daughter, as tenants in common, and a copy of this decree showing the vesting of said real estate should be recorded in the office of the County of Recorder in which said real estate is located.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED, BY THE COURT AS FOLLOWS:

1. Said Final Report and Account of said Personal Representative is hereby in all things approved, settled, and confirmed.

2. That the distribution of the balance of the property remaining in said personal representative's hands for distribution has been made pursuant to the distribution set forth in the final accounting to the decedent's heir at law, and hereby in all things approved.

3. That pursuant to the laws on intestacy, the following described real estate, to-wit:


Lot 2, Block 6, Wicker Park, in the Town of Munster as shown in Plat Book 20, page 40, in Lake County, Indiana.


is hereby vested in Janet E. Bartok, wife; Marcia Bartok, daughter; Gayle Kaczmark, daughter, as tenants in common.
