ORDER APPROVING EXECUTRIX'S FINAL REPORT  
AND ACCOUNTING, PETITION TO ALLOW ACCOUNTING, AND  
PETITION FOR ORDER APPROVING DISTRIBUTION AND CLOSING ESTATE  
CLERK LAKE SUPERIOR COURT

This cause came to be heard on the 23rd day of October, 1987,  
upon the final account, petition to settle and allow account and for  
authority to distribute estate filed by Lydia Laster, as Executrix  
of the estate of Willie L. Laster, deceased, which account and petition  
are in the words and figures following, to-wit:

And it appearing that no objections were filed thereto and the  
Court being fully advised in the premises now finds that:

1. Due notices of the filing of said account and petition and of  
the hearing on the same were given to all persons interested in said  
estate, and the same are now properly before the Court for final action  
thereon.

2. That Willie L. Laster, died testate, a resident of the County  
of Lake, State of Indiana, on December 20, 1974, and his Last Will  
and Testament was duly admitted to probate before this Court on  
December 27, 1974, and this Court appointed said Lydia Laster as  
executrix of the Last Will and Testament of the decedent, and said  
executrix was issued Letters of Testamentary on December 27, 1974, to  
her and since that date she has continued to serve in such capacity.

3. That the matters and things stated in said account and petition  
are true, and that said executrix has accounted for all the assets in  
said estate coming into her hands.

4. More than five (5) months have elapsed since the date of first  
published notice to legatees, devisees and creditors of said decedent;  
all claims filed against said estate have been paid and discharged;  
neither said decedent nor his executrix were employers of labor within  
the meaning of that term as used in the Indiana Employment Security  
Act; all estate taxes, inheritance taxes and gross income taxes, if any,  
assessed in said estate have been paid.

5. The following persons are the sole legatees and devisees under

same as Lydia Washington, Lydia Michelle Laster and Lyndon John Laster and that all assets and property of this estate remaining after payment of decedent's debts and expenses of administration has been distributed to the above-named persons, as evidenced by Affidavit in Lieu of Voucher which is attached hereto and made a part of this accounting.

6. That the decedent owned a certain piece of real estate located at 2057 Willard St., Gary, Lake County, Indiana, more particularly described as follows:

Lot Seventeen (17), in Block Ten (10), Tarrytown First Subdivision, in the City of Gary, as shown in Plat Book 30, page 13, in Lake County, Indiana.

and that the decedent devised said real estate in Article 2 of his Last Will and Testament to Lydia Laster, same as Lydia Washington, Lydia Michelle Laster, and Lyndon John Laster, equally, and a copy of this decree showing the vesting of said real estate should be recorded in the office of the County Recorder in which said real estate is located.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court as follows:

1. Said Final Report and Account of said executrix is hereby in all things approved, settled and confirmed.

2. That the distribution of the balance of the property remaining in said executrix's hands for distribution has been made pursuant to the distribution set forth in the final accounting as prescribed under the Last Will and Testament of said decedent and is hereby in all things approved.

3. That pursuant to the decedent's Last Will and Testament the following described real estate, to-wit:

Lot Seventeen (17), in Block Ten (10), Tarrytown First Subdivision, in the City of Gary, as shown in Plat Book 30, page 13, in Lake County, Indiana.

is hereby vested in Lydia Laster, one and same as Lydia Washington, Lydia Michelle Laster and Lyndon John Laster, equally, pursuant to the provision of the decedent's Last Will and Testament.

And that said executrix is hereby directed to procure and record in the office of the Recorder of Lake County, being the county in which said real estate is located, a certified copy of this Final Decree.

4. Said executrix having made distribution of all assets and property and having attached Affidavit in Lieu of Vouchers evidencing said distribution to said legatees and devisees, said distribution is hereby approved and confirmed.

5. Said executrix is hereby released and discharged from any further liability or responsibility along with her surety as said executrix of the estate of Willie L. Laster. All of which is ordered this 23rd day of October, 1987.
