ORDER APPROVING CO-EXECUTORS' FINAL ACCOUNT,
PETITION TO SETTLE AND ALLOW ACCOUNT,
PETITION FOR AUTHORITY TO DISTRIBUTE ASSETS REMAINING
AND CLOSE ESTATE

This cause came to be heard on the 2nd day of Sept, 1988, upon the final account, petition to settle and allow account, and for authority to distribute estate filed by Walter Porter and Emma Queen, as co-executors of the estate of Louise P. Williams, deceased, which account and petition are in the words and figures following, to-wit:

And it appearing that no objections were filed thereto, and the Court being duly advised in the premises, now finds that:

1. Due notices of the filing of said account and petition, and of the hearing on the same were, given to all persons interested in said estate, and the same are now properly before the Court for final action thereon.
2. That Louise P. Williams died testate, a residence of the County of Lake, State of Indiana, on the 30th day of December, 1979, and her Last Will and Testament was duly admitted to probate before this Court on the 15th day of February, 1980, and this Court appointed said Walter Porter and Emma Queen as co-personal representatives of the Last Will and Testament of the decedent, and said co-executors were issued Letters Testamentary on the 15th day of February, 1980, and since that date they have continued to serve in such capacity.
3. That the matters and things stated in said account and petition are true, and that said co-executors have accounted for all the assets in said estate coming into their hands.
4. That more than five (5) months have elapsed since the date of the first published notice to legatees, devisees and creditors of said decedent; all claims filed

against said estate have been paid and discharged; neither said decedent nor her co-executors were an employer of labor within the meaning of that term as used in the Indiana Employment Security Act; and all estate taxes, inheritance taxes and gross income taxes, if any, assessed in said estate have been paid.

5. The following persons are the sole legatees and devisees under the decedent's Last Will and Testament: Walter Porter - 1/2 of net estate, and Emma Queen - 1/2 of net estate, and that all assets and property of this estate remaining after payment of decedent's debts and expenses of administration have already been distributed to the above-named persons, who are the same as the co-executors herein.

6. That the decedent owned a certain piece of real estate located at 2421 Delaware, in the County of Lake, State of Indiana, more particularly described as follows:

Lot Forty Three (43), Block Thirteen (13), except that part in the rear of said Lot taken for alley purposes, Chicago-Tolleston Land and Investment Company's Oak Park Addition to Tolleston, in City of Gary, Lake County, Indiana.

And in accordance with the terms of the family settlement agreement heretofore approved by this Court, said real estate should now vest entirely in the name of Walter Porter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court as follows:

1. That said final account of said co-executors is hereby, in all things, approved, settled and confirmed.
2. That the distribution of the balance of the property remaining in said co-executors' hands for distribution has been made pursuant to the distribution set forth in the final account as prescribed under the Last Will and Testament of said decedent, and is hereby, in all things, approved.
3. That pursuant to the decedent's Last Will and Testament and the family settlement agreement hereto approved by the Court, the following described real estate, to-wit:

Lot Forty Three (43), Block Thirteen (13), except that part in the rear of said Lot taken for alley purposes, Chicago-Tolleston Land and Investment Company's Oak Park Addition to Tolleston, in City of Gary, Lake County, Indiana.

is hereby vested in Walter Porter pursuant to the provisions of the decedent's Last Will and Testament.

And that said co-executors are hereby directed to procure and record in the Office of the Recorder of Lake County, being the Court in which said real estate is located, a certified copy of this Final Decree.

4. That said co-executors, having made distribution of all assets and property, said distribution is hereby approved and confirmed.

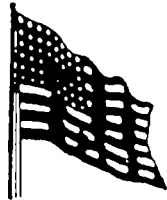
5. That said co-executors are hereby released and discharged from any further liability or responsibility, along with their surety, as said co-executors of the estate of Louise P. Williams.
