And that said co-executors are hereby directed to procure and record in the Office of the Recorder of Lake County, being the Court in which said real estate is licented, a certified copy of this Final Decree.

- 4. That said co-executors, having made distribution of all assets and property, said distribution is hereby approved and confirmed.
- 5. That said co-executors are hereby released and discharged from any further liability or responsibility, along with their surety, as said co-executors of the estate of Louise P. Williams.
