ORDINANCE FOR GRANTING A VACATION OF A PUBLIC WAY

WHEREAS, the following proposed vacation has been reviewed by the City C.L.C. Plan Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the city of Gary, Indiana now finds that the following vacation is in and not injurious to the public interest; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council now finds that the area sought to be vacated is not necessary to the growth of the City of Gary; the vacation would not make access to the land of others impossible; and the vacation would not eliminate the public's access to a church, school and other public building or place; and

WHEREAS, due notice of this vacation has been given to the public and public hearing has been held in accordance with state law; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council finds that the granting of this vacation will not result in any damage to any adjoining property owner;

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the city of Gary, Indiana as follows:

Section 1. The following described property is hereby vacated:

Those portions of Hayes Street not vacated between Alley Number 5A south to 7th Avenue.

- A) Potential economic impact to the City:  
The City would be completely relieved of any further maintenance, snow removal and repair costs for the vacated premises. This would free those funds for other needed work in the City. The City would also be relieved of any further tort liability for accidents occurring on such premises.
- B) Potential economic impact to Methodist:  
Methodist Hospital would assume all future maintenance, snow removal and repair costs for the vacated premises. These parcels currently serve as nothing more than city maintained roadways for the sole benefit of the hospital and vacation would require the hospital to foot the bill for all of its roadways. Following the transfer of ownership, there would also be the transfer of all liability for accidents occurring on its property.



STAFF RECOMMENDATION 89-21, 22

The petitioner, Methodist Hospitals, Inc., purpose to vacate portions of Hayes Street and Alley Number 5A south is to complete there parking lot and access plans as outlined in the master plan for the Gary Medical Center Special Interest District of 1973.

Therefore, as a part of the Master Plan for the Special Interest District as previous approved by the Plan Commission, staff would recommend APPROVAL provided:

1. Access to any existing hospital structure is not jeopardized.
2. That all affected utilities are granted easement rights.
