MATICLE I. Hame and Purpose

Soction I. Name

The name of this organization shall be the Coder Lake Church of Christ, Incorporate of Ocdar Lake, Indiana.

Section 2. Purpose

The purpose of this Church shall be as revealed in the New Testament, to win people to faith in Jesus Christ that they man accept Him as their personal Saviour and Redeemer, and commit them actively to the Church: to help them grow in the grace and knowledge of Christ and increasingly they may know and do his will. It's members shall be known as Christians only: d the Church shall be congregational in form of government and have no creed or archeles of faith other than those contained in the New Testament.

ARTICLE II. Membership

S. ction I. Momborship

The membership of the Church chart to these position to be be a shall unite with are identified now as members of the congregation and those who shall unite with it by confession of faith and beptism or by transfer of membership from another church or receipt of their church letter providing they have fulfilled the requirements as above, or by personal statement that they have fulfilled said requirements in the event their church letter is not available. (Baptism shall mean immersion in water.)

Scotion 2. Authority

The investment of power is congregate and and the action of the congregation is final. Active members, 16 years of age or over, are eligible to east one vote on matters before the congregation for action, when present. An active member is one who has continued steadfast in assembly with this church and breaking of bread.

ARTICLE III. Creicors

Section 1. Officers

The following Officers shall be elected by the Church congregation at its annual business meeting for the term of one year. (Ballots to con a Yes and No blanks for voting on all officers.)

Trustees to be elected for term of 3 years, one being replaced each year. In case of vacancy, the required number to be elected to obtain this minimum. These officers not to be part of the general board. (1) Bible School sceretary. (2) Song leader. (3) Primary Sunday School Supt.

Section 2. Duries

A. The Elders shall promote the growth and welfare of the Church; give spiritual oversight to the members with respect to regular attendance at the Lord's Supper, visitation of the sick and merally delinquent and the spiritually indifferent; serve at the Lord's Table; and perform such other duties as the New Testament directs.

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· 2. . 3. The Deacons shall cooperate with the elders in promoting the growth and wiffers of the church, be responsible for greeting and unharing the worshippers, bedributing the Lord's Suppor, receiving the offerings, ministering to the needy of the Church, and such other duties as they may be assigned. G. The trustees shall act as the legal agents of the Church in all business metters under the direction of the general board and subject to approval of the Church; hold legal title to all Church property and handle all business transactions thereto; be responsible for the care and maintenance of church property including insurance coverage; have supervision over all endowment and trust funds, and perform such duties as are required by the laws of the State of Indiana. Senior Trustce to act as chairman. Section 3. Election of Officers A newinating committee composed of three, one of whom shall be the member or the board of Elders, shall be appointed by the Chairmen, approved by the General Board and announced to the congregation at least (8) reaks prior to the annual business meeting, to nominate conditates for efficers for the Church.

All suggestions from the congregation for nominees shall be in the hands of the committee at least (10) days prior to the annual business meeting. The committee shall report its nominations to the congregation at the annual business meeting. ill nominees who receives a majority of the votes, pour by those present and voting

Vacancia in any office of this church shall be filled, for the unexpired term, by nomination of the General Board and elected by the congregation.

Section 4. The General Board

- A. The General Board shall consist of the duly elected officers of the church.
- B. Not less than one week after the election of the officers the Chairman of the general board shall call a special meeting of the officers elect for the purpose of effecting a permanent organization, as follows: All olders elected shall meet and organize the Board of Elders, which she'l be a Chairman and a Secretary. The Deacons cleet shall meet and elect a Chairman and a Secretary. After the sub organization have been offected, all officers elect shall meet in general section to
- organize the General Board, which shall be composed of the following: Chairman, Sceretary, Financial Secretary Rected Church Treasurer. These officers shall be billed from among the elected. Ers of the General Board.

 O. The Chairman shall full it is usual duties of such an office, call and preside at all reguler or special by measurementings of the congregation, and serve as Chairman of the General Board. In his absence or failure to provide, then the (Senior) Trustee shall preside. The same procedure shall ensue in Elders and Deceous Boards respectfully. The respective treasurer shall receive and disburse all funds of the Church according to the authority designated to them by the General all funds of the Church according to the authority designated to them by the General Board and shall make a monthly report of the same to the General Board. The General Board shall be responsible for the selection of other treasurers, elerks, or secretories as needed. The Bible School Superintendent shall have jurisdiction over the Bible School and shall be responsible to the Doard of Religious Education. (This Board, unless otherwise specified, shall consist of the elected Elders .)
 - D. It shall be the duty of the General Board:
 - 1. To consider and recommend to the Congregation general policies.

 - To transact business.
 To administer the program of the Church.
- 4. To appoint, through its chairman, committees to carry out the Church program. Such committees to include Finance, Baptism, House, Music committees to serve for one year.
- E. The G. neral Board shall be form its dutir according to the authority granted in the consititution or designated to it by the Church congregation.

Section 1. Duties

The minister shall perform all the a less which usually pertain to that office. as spiritual administrator of the Church he shall be ex-officio member of all organtood groups, auxilliaries and committees, and shall abstain from making motions and voting.

Section 2. Selection.

- The elders Board shall constitue the Pulpit Committee and as such shall be responsible for recommending a prospective minister to the General Beard. It will be their duty to supply the pulpit in the absence of the minister.
- B. The general board shall consider the recommendation the Pulpit committee and if approved, recommend the prospective minister to the congregation. It shall be the policy of the Church to consider only one prospective minister at a time.
- C. A prospective minister must eary 75% of votes east to be accepted as minister of this church, voting in a regular or special business meeting of the con-

ARTICLE V. Amondments.

Section 1.

This Constitution may be amended at any business meeting of the Church, by a two-thirds vote of the numbers present and voting on the proposed ammendment, proposed amondment, providing written notice of the proposed changes or additions has been read to the members of the Congregation at the successive regular Sunday services prior to the voting, or written notice has given the membership at least two weeks before the vote is taken.

BY - LAWS

- I. The Church year shall begin on I first Sunday in January of each year.
- II. The annual business meeting of the Church shall be hold during the first fifteen days of December of each successive year.
- III. The General Board shall hold its regular meetings on the first Friday of each month. All other boards shall set their own meeting times.
- W. All business meetings of the Church, and the General Board shell be governed by Robert's Rules of Order.
- . The General Board shall hold special meetings as required on call of the Chairman or upon request of five (5) or more members, and the number present shall constitue a quorum. The same applies to the Elders and Deacons except the petition need be by three (3) members only.
- VI. The Church shall held special meetings as the required; such meetings to be called by the General Board chairman or by written metition of Twenty (20) or mere members of the Congregation.
- III. Notice of all the special or regular business weetings of the congregation shall be given at the Sunday services of the Church at least one work in advance of the proposed meeting, quarterly Congregational meeting to be hold the first Friday of January, April, July and October.

BY - IA'S

- OIT.A quorum of the General Board shall be one-half of its duly constituted members, and the same shall provail in the Elders and Deacons, except that when quorum is not present and there is sufficient cause for a meeting, then The Chairman of such board shall call a special meeting, giving due and proper notice, and minimum of five (5) members present shall constitue a quorum.
- IX. Repeated absence from any Board meetings, without just cause, shall reduce the total number of members when determining and counting for a quorum.
- A. Those by-laws may be changed or added to by a majority vote of the members of the General Board present and voting in regular or special meeting, previded that the proposed changes or a ditions have been submitted in writing to the membership, at least two works in advance, prior to the voting.
