PARCEL 1: PART OF GOVERNMENT LOTS 2 AND 3, IN THE EAST HALF (E-1/2) OF THE WEST HALF (W-1/2) AND THE WEST HALF (W-1/2) OF THE EAST HALF (E-1/2) OF SECTION 6, TOWNSHIP 37 NORTH, RANGE 9 WEST OF THE SECOND PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE WEST LINE OF U.S. GOVERNMENT LOT 2 AND THE NORTH LINE OF THE 100-FOOT RIGHT-OF-WAY OF THE CHICAGO, LAKE SHORE RAILWAY (NOW ELGIN, JOLIET AND EASTERN RAILROAD) AS LOCATED IN SAID LOTS 2 AND 3; THENCE NORTH ON SAID WEST LINE OF LOT 2 A DISTANCE OF 173.20 FEET; THENCE NORTH 41 DEGREES 09 MINUTES 00 SECONDS (41°09'00") EAST, 92 FEET, MORE OR LESS, TO THE WATERS' EDGE OF LAKE MICHIGAN; THENCE SOUTHEASTERLY ALONG SAID WATERS' EDGE TO THE EAST LINE OF GOVERNMENT LOT 3 (THE EAST LINE OF THE WEST HALF (W-1/2) OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER (SE-1/4) OF SECTION 6, TOWNSHIP 37 NORTH, RANGE 9 WEST OF THE SECOND PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN); THENCE SOUTHERLY ALONG THE EAST LINE OF THE WEST HALF (W-1/2) OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER (SE-1/4) OF SAID SECTION 6 A DISTANCE OF 252 FEET, MORE OR LESS, TO THE NORTHERLY LINE OF THE ELGIN, JOLIET AND EASTERN RAILROAD; THENCE NORTHWESTERLY ALONG THE NORTHERLY LINE OF SAID RAILROAD 3,222.07 FEET, MORE OR LESS, TO THE PLACE OF BEGINNING, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA; CONTAINING 12.02 ACRES OF LAND AS OF MARCH 22, 1979.

PARCEL 2: A PARCEL OF LAND BEING 43.5 FEET WIDE LYING ADJACENT TO AND NORTHEAST OF THE ELGIN, JOLIET AND EASTERN RAILWAY PROPERTY IN THE SOUTHEAST 1/4, SECTION 6, TOWNSHIP 37 NORTH, RANGE 9 WEST OF THE SECOND PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA, DESCRIBED AS COMMENCING AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 6; THENCE NORTH 0°48'47" WEST ALONG THE EAST SECTION LINE 89 FEET MORE OR LESS TO THE NORTHERLY RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF THE ELGIN, JOLIET AND EASTERN RAILWAY BEING THE POINT OF BEGINNING; THENCE NORTH 53°42'30" WEST ALONG SAID NORTHERLY LINE 1634 FEET MORE OR LESS TO THE WEST LINE OF THE EAST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4, SECTION 6; THENCE NORTH 0°42'59" WEST ALONG SAID WEST LINE 54.57 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 53°42'30" EAST PARALLEL WITH AND 43.5 FEET FROM THE NORTHERN LINE OF THE ELGIN, JOLIET AND EASTERN RAILWAY 1634 FEET MORE OR LESS TO THE EAST SECTION LINE; THENCE SOUTH 0°48'47" EAST ALONG SAID EAST LINE 54.54 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING. CONTAINING 1.63 ACRES AND SUBJECT TO ALL LEGAL HIGHWAYS AND EASEMENTS.

OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS, It appears that the boundaries have been set by the Indiana General Assembly in the order of the following described land, to-wit:

All that part of Lots Two (2) and Three (3), in Section Eight (8), Township Thirteenth-northern (37) North, Indiana, between the Northwesterly right of way line of the Michigan, Elliott and Cauchon Railroad, so-called Chicago, Lake Shore and Michigan Railroad, and the Southwesterly shore of Lake Michigan, and bounded on the Northwest by lands of the City of Munster and on the Southeast by lands of the City of Gary, all in Lake County, Indiana.

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And, whereas, I, William E. Gatch, Surveyor of the State of Indiana, Esq., County Recorder of Lake County, Indiana, duly certified by said Samuel J. Brownell, as County Surveyor and Engineer on November 17, 1907, that same fixed in the office of the Secretary of the State of Indiana, which may be certified as to Indiana the boundaries fixed by the United States within which said Baltimore and Ohio and Chicago Railroad Company is authorized to run in Lake Michigan.

And, whereas, said order has in all respects complied with the provisions of Chapter 91, of the law of the State of Indiana, passed at the regular session of the General Assembly, begun on the tenth day of January, 1907.

Now, therefore, I, William E. Gatch, Governor of the State of Indiana, by virtue of the authority invested upon me and by the terms of said act, do hereby grant to Baltimore and Ohio and Chicago Railroad Company the privilege and authority to run in and improve the unoccupied land lying between the end of said above described tract of land and the said dock or harbor line; said space will be

marged land being more accurately described as follows, to-wit:

All that certain land in the bed of Lake Michigan situated in Section 6 and 6, Township 37 North, Range 9 West and Section 31 Township 30 North, Range 9 West of the Second Principal Meridian in the Cities of Munising and Whitefish, County of Lake, State of Indiana, as shown on "Plat of Survey of the shore line of that part of Lake Michigan, northwesterly of Lots 2 and 3 of Section 6 - 37 - D of the Second Principal Meridian and to a line where the water does not exceed 20 foot in depth", prepared by C. K. Wallace, County Surveyor and Engineer, dated April 5, 1929, and recorded according to available official data on hand by George E. Brownson, County Surveyor and Engineer on November 10th, 1940, bounded and described as follows, to-wit;

Begins at the point of intersection of the northerly line of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 6, Township 37 North, Range 9 West with the southeasterly shore line of Lake Michigan as indicated on Plat of Survey prepared by C. K. Wallace as aforesaid, said northerly line also being the northerly line of Lot 2 of said Section 6, in Lake Avenue, said point of intersection being 500.00 feet, measured northwardly along the northerly line of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of said Section 6 from the intersection thereof with the southerly line of property acquired by Baltimore and Ohio Trust Company from Harry A. and Amy J. Roberto, Lynbrook, by Deed dated January 9, 1901, and recorded in the Lake County Recorder's Office of the Land Records of Lake County, Indiana;

Thence, N 41° 09' E, 3100.00 feet to a point;

Thence, S 40° 12' E, 3270.00 feet to a point;

Thence, S 41° 00' E, 3200.00 feet to the point of intersection of the southerly line of Lot 3 of said Section 6, Township 37 North, Range 9 West, in Huron Avenue, with the southeasterly shore line of Lake Michigan as indicated on Plat of Survey prepared by C. K. Wallace as aforesaid, said point of survey being 43° N, 140.02 feet, measured along said easterly line of lot 3 from the intersection thereof with the southerly line of property acquired by Baltimore and Ohio and Chicago Railroad Company from Chicago, Lake and Ohio and Chicago Railway Company by indenture dated July 10th and Eastern Railway Company by indenture dated April 10, 1919, and recorded in Record 200, page 333 of the Land Records of Lake County, Indiana, being a re-execution of the deed between the above parties, dated October 24, 1902 and referred to in the release from John Wilcox Brown and James Bond, trustee, dated January 12, 1903, and from New York Trust Company, trustee, by indenture dated April 12, 1917 and recorded in Record 103, page 404 of said Land Records;

Thence, along said southeasterly shore line of Lake Michigan to the point of beginning, containing 236 acres, more or less.

Being the land in the bed of Lake Michigan adjoining all three regular rights as acquired by Baltimore and Ohio

and Chicago Railroad Company from Harry A. and May J. Hobart,
Hobart, by deed dated January 9, 1901 by Alexander and
Oliver O. Forsyth, et al., by deed dated January 9, 1901,
and recorded in Record 90, page 309 of the Land Records
of Lake County, Indiana;

for greater certainty reference is hereby made to said plat of survey on file with the Secretary of State, for the State of Indiana,
certified by Samuel R. Thompson, County Surveyor, of Lake County,
Indiana, on November 17th, 1940, to be a correct map, showing
and defining the above described property and dock or harbor line,
which survey is made a part of each of the above descriptions.

PROVIDED, also, that when any portion of said map shall
be filled in by said Baltimore and Ohio and Chicago Railroad Company,
then said Baltimore and Ohio and Chicago Railroad Company
shall be entitled to a sum from the State of Indiana, for the por-
tion so filled.
