This cause came to be heard on the 27th day of April 1990, upon the final account, petition to settle and allow account and for authority to distribute estate filed by Robert G. Burch, as personal representative of the estate of Dorothy V. Burch, deceased, which account and petition are in the words and figures following, to-wit:

DULY ENTERED FOR TAXATION SUBJECT TO FINAL ACCEPTANCE FOR TRANSFER.

And it appearing that no objections were filed thereto and the Court being fully advised in the premises, now find that:

APR 27 1990

1. Due notices of the filing of said account and petition and of the hearing on the same were given to all persons interested in said estate, and the same are now properly before the Court for final action thereon.

2. That Dorothy V. Burch, died testate, a resident of the County of Lake, State of Indiana, on the 26th day of May, 1989, and her Last Will and Testament was duly admitted to probate before this Court on the 16th day of June, 1989, and this Court appointed said Robert G. Burch as personal representative of the Last Will and Testament of the decedent, and said personal representative was issued Letters Testamentary on the 16th day of June, 1989, and since that date he has continued to serve in such capacity.

3. That the matters and things stated in said account and petition are true and that said personal representative has accounted for all of the assets in this estate coming into his hands.

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4. More than five (5) months have elapsed since the date of the first published notice to legatees, devisees, and the creditors of said decedent; all claims filed against said estate have been paid and discharged; neither said decedent nor her personal representative were employers of labor within the meaning of that term as used in the Indiana Employment Security Act; all estate taxes, inheritance taxes and gross income taxes, if any, assessed in said estate have been paid.

5. The following persons are the sole legatees and devisees under the decedent's Last Will and Testament:

Bernard E. Burch

Robert G. Burch

Roberta V. Harris,

and that all assets and property of this estate remaining after payment of decedent's debts and expenses of administration, said distribution should be made to the above-named parties as set forth above.

6. That the decedent owned certain piece of real estate located at:

and said parcel of real estate was devised equally to Robert G. Burch and Roberta V. Harris as joint tenants with the right of survivorship under the decedent's Last Will and Testament.

Lot 22 as marked and laid down on the recorded plat of Parcels 4,5,6 and 7 of Blalock's Orchard Addition to the City of Valparaiso, Indiana as the same appears on the record in Miscellaneous Record 11, Page 561 in the Office of the Recorder of Porter County, Indiana.

and that the decedent devised said real estate in her Last Will and Testament to Bernard E. Burch, Robert G. Burch and

Roberta V. Harris as tenants in common.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court as follows:

1. Said Final Report and Account of said personal representative is hereby in all things approved, settled and confirmed.

2. That the distribution of the balance of the property remaining in said personal representative's hands for distribution should be made pursuant to the distribution set forth in the final accounting as pre-scribed under the Last Will and Testament of said decedent and is hereby in all things approved.

3. That pursuant to the decedent's Last Will and Testament the following described real estate, to-wit:

- 1) Residence - 644 State St., County of Lake, City of Hobart, Indiana

Lot 5 and the South 13 feet of Lot 4 in Block in George and William Earles 2nd Subdivision, in the City of Hobart, as per plat thereof, recorded in Plat Book 6 page 45 in the Office of the Recorder of Lake County, Indiana.

is hereby vested in Robert G. Burch and Roberta V. Harris pursuant to the provisions of the decedent's Last Will and Testament, and

- 2) 1/7th interest in 1521 Elm Court, County of Porter, City of Valparaiso, Indiana

Lot 22 as marked and laid down on the recorded plat of Parcels 4, 5, 6 and 7 of Blalock's Orchard Addition to the City of Valparaiso, Indiana as the same appears on the record in Miscellaneous Record 11, Page 561 in the Office of the Recorder of Porter County, Indiana


is hereby vested equally in Bernard E. Burch, Robert G. Burch and Roberta V. Harris pursuant to the provisions of the decedent's Last Will and Testament.

And that said personal representative is hereby directed to procure and record in the office of the Recorder of Lake and Porter County, being the counties in which said real estate is located, a certified copy of this Final Decree.

4. Said personal representative is hereby directed to distribute the balance of the assets available for final distribution pursuant to the provisions of the decedent's Last Will and Testament.

5. Said personal representative is hereby directed to file his Supplement Report showing that he has complied with the terms of this order and that said personal representative has in all things carried out the provisions of this final decree, or hereby released and discharged from any further liability or responsibility as said personal representative of the estate of Dorothy V. Burch.
