ORDER APPROVING ADMINISTRATRIX'S

And it appearing that no objections were filed thereto and the Court being fully advised in the premises now finds that:



1. Due notices of the filing of said account and petition and of the hearing on the same were given to all persons interested in said estate and the same are now properly before the Court for final action thereon.

2. That MINNIE P. WOODS died intestate, a resident of the County of Lake, State of Indiana, on the 31st day of October, 1985, and said Administratrix was issued Letters of Administration on the 24th day of December, 1985, to her and since that date she has continued to serve in such capacity.

3. That the matters and things stated in said account and petition are true and that said Administratrix has accounted for all of the assets in this estate coming into her hands.

4. More than five (5) months have elapsed since the date of the first published notice to the heirs and creditors of said decedent; all claims filed against said estate have been paid and discharged; neither said Decedent nor her Administratrix was an employer of labor within the meaning of that term as used in the Indiana Employment Security Act; all estate taxes, inheritance taxes and gross income taxes, if any, assessed in said estate have been paid.


3. That pursuant to the laws of intestacy the following described real estate, to-wit:

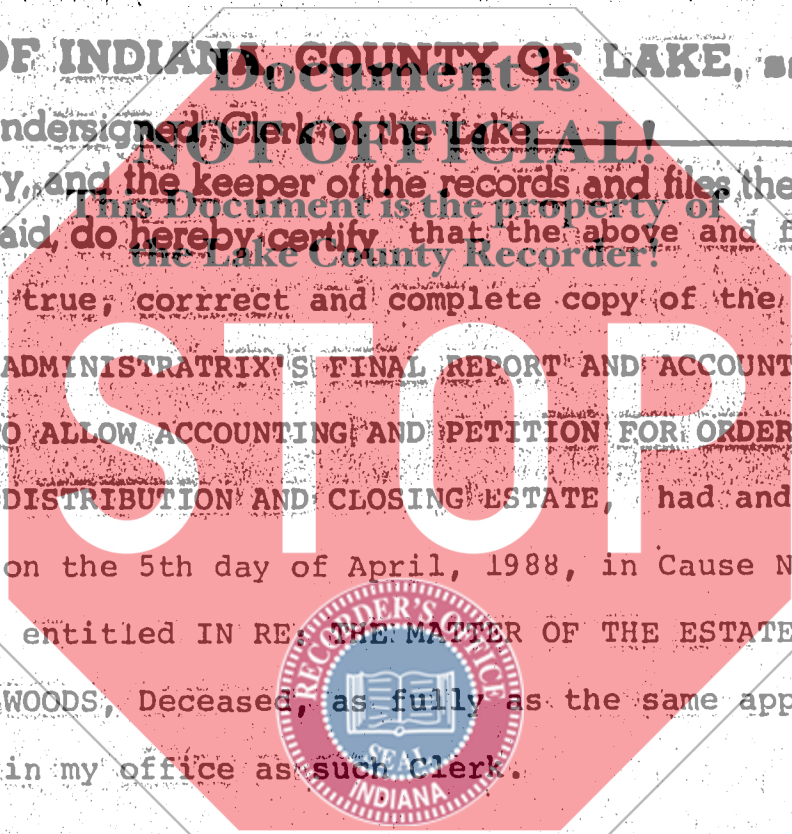
