After laboratory analysis of soil samples it was found that most of the affected area was contaminated with # 2 heating oil.

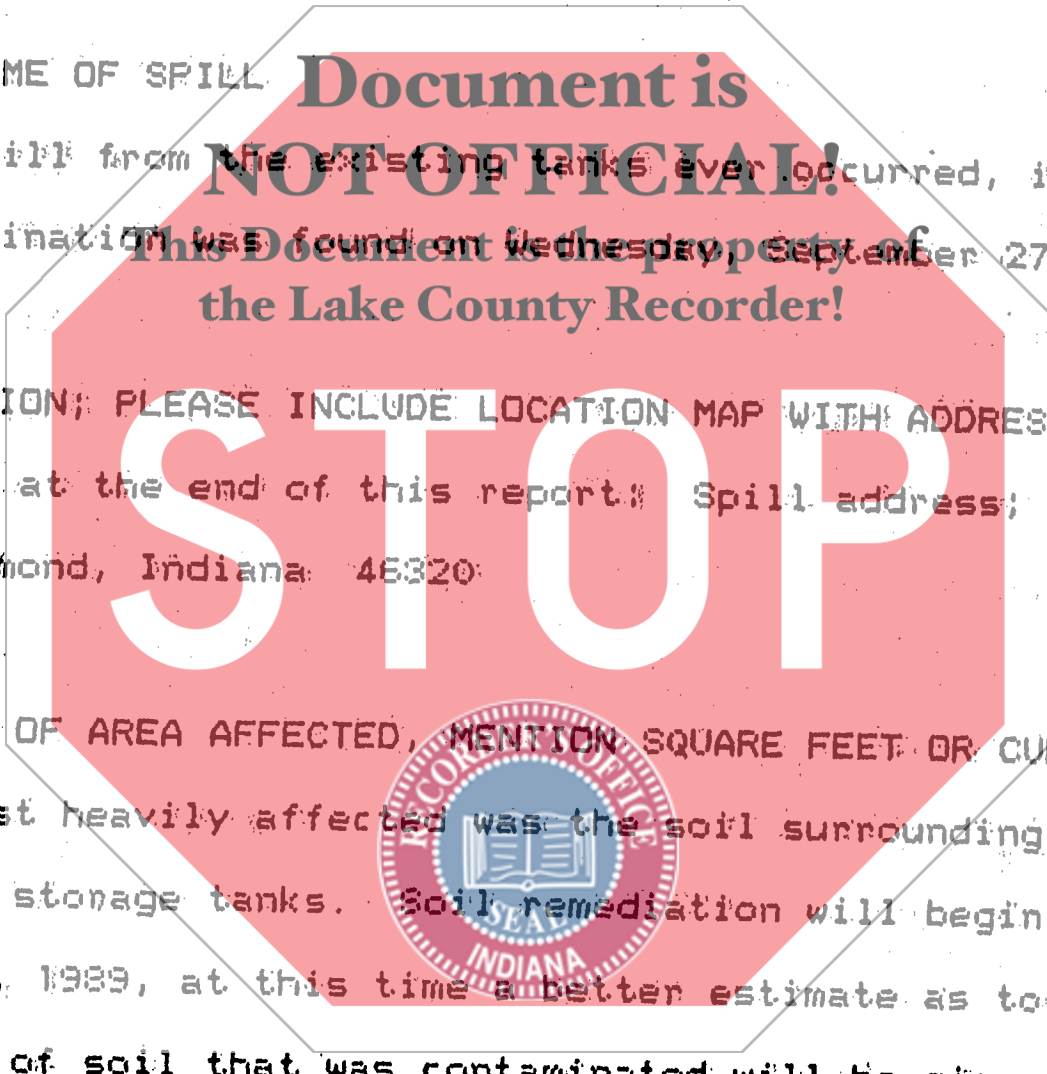

CONTAINMENT & CLEANUP ACTIVITIES (WITH DATES)

ICEP, Inc. plans to remove all contaminated soil away from the current excavation area to a point in which 4 clean soil samples can be obtained. The objective of the soil cleanup is to have these samples pass a Total Petroleum Hydrocarbon test. We expect to have these samples come back with results no greater than 100 parts per million. A copy of these results will be included in the general site assessment that will be made available to your office upon the completion of our remediation.

On your recommendation, ICEP, Inc. also plans to install 6-2 inch PVC screened monitoring wells at various points on site. (These points can be found by looking at diagrams B & C at the end of this report.) Three wells will be put into place at each excavation hole, two wells downgrade and one upgrade. Laboratory analytical reports from the first water samples from these wells will be made available to you in the general site assessment turned in at the end of this project. Remediation and the installation of these wells will begin on Tuesday, November 28, 1989, and total remediation should conclude no later than Friday, December 8, 1989.

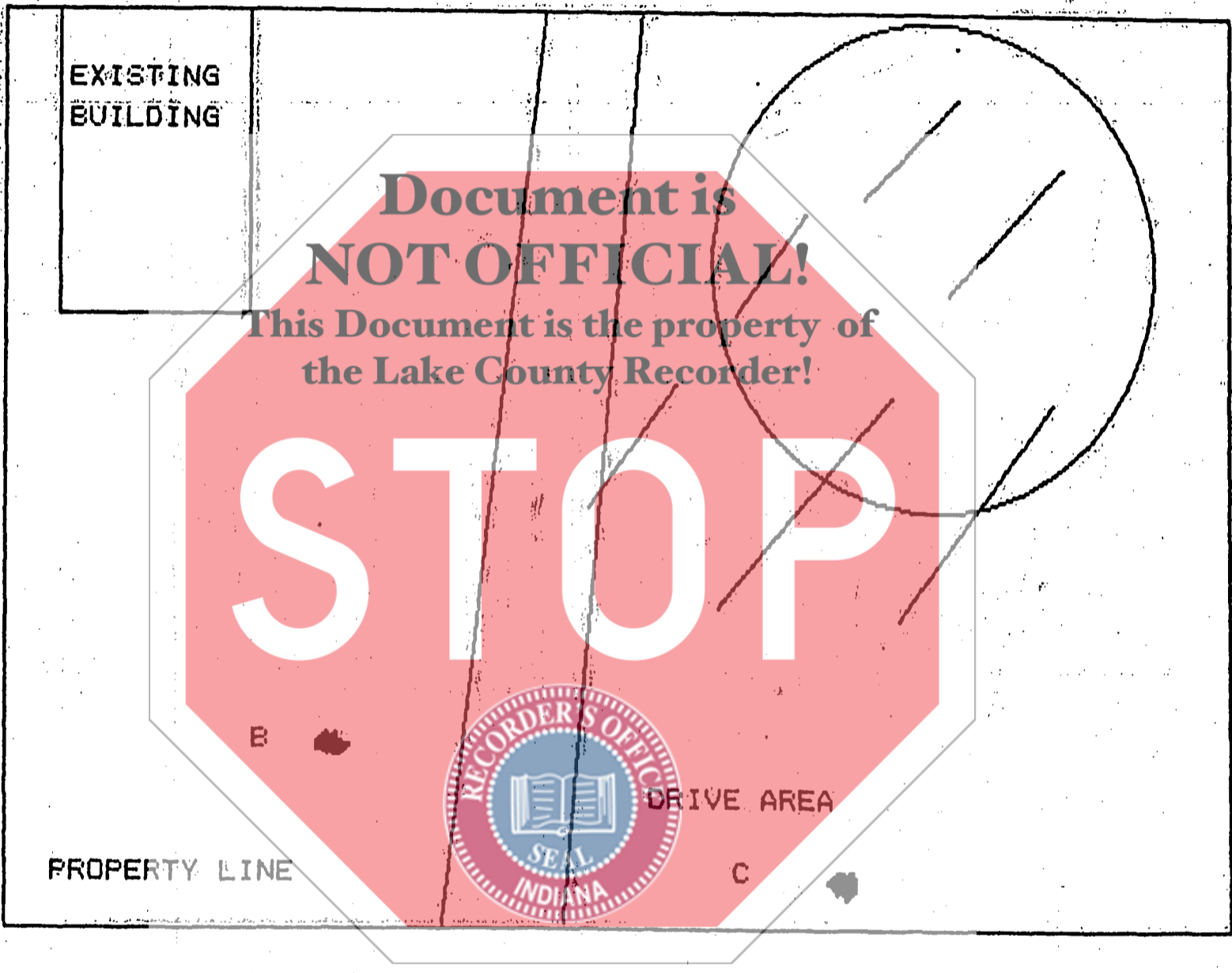

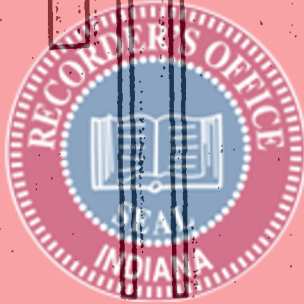

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On August 22, 1989, we received your letter indicating your intent to close two (2) underground storage tank(s) located at 12750 Sheffield Avenue, Hammond, Indiana. You may begin closing your tank(s) on or after September 22, 1989. A site assessment (soil borings or soil samples) must be performed in accordance with 40 CFR Part 280 Subpart G, to assess whether a release has occurred. It will be necessary for you to make arrangements with the private laboratory you wish to use for testing of the soil samples required for the site assessment prior to the closure date. The analysis must be performed using a GC/FID method. During closure if free product, ground or surface water contamination, or off-site soil contamination is found, please call AC 317/241-4336 to report this release. If only on-site soil shows contamination, please call AC 317/243-5022 to report this release. Please notify the State Fire Marshal's office two (2) weeks prior to the tank(s) closure. If your closure date should change, please contact the Indiana Department of Environmental Management at AC 317/243-5151 and advise us of the change.

Once you have completed closing your tank(s), please fill out the enclosed notification form. If this is not an initial filing, please mark the amended box. The notification form must be completely filled out and must have an original signature. Closure records must be kept on site for at least three (3) years. If they cannot be kept on site, they can be sent to this office to be filed with our records. Closure records include site assessment results disposal documents, Fire Department closure work sheet, and other documents regarding the closure of the tank.

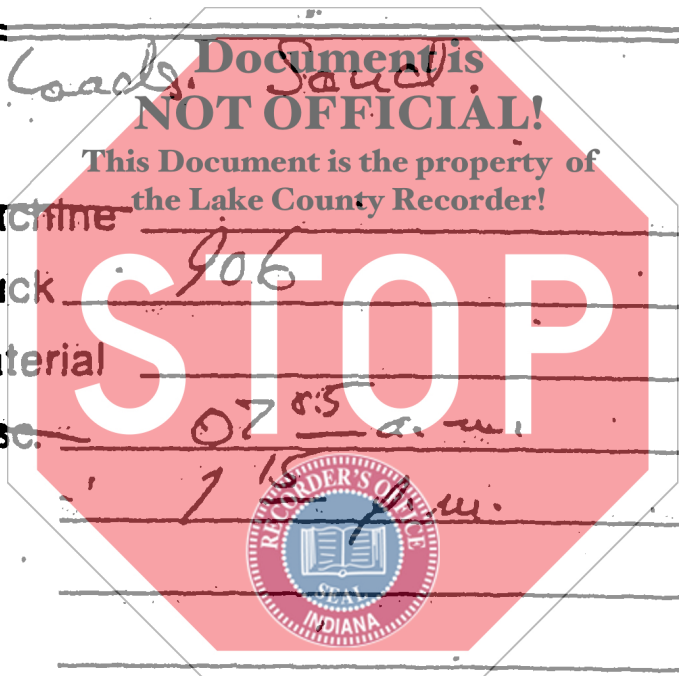

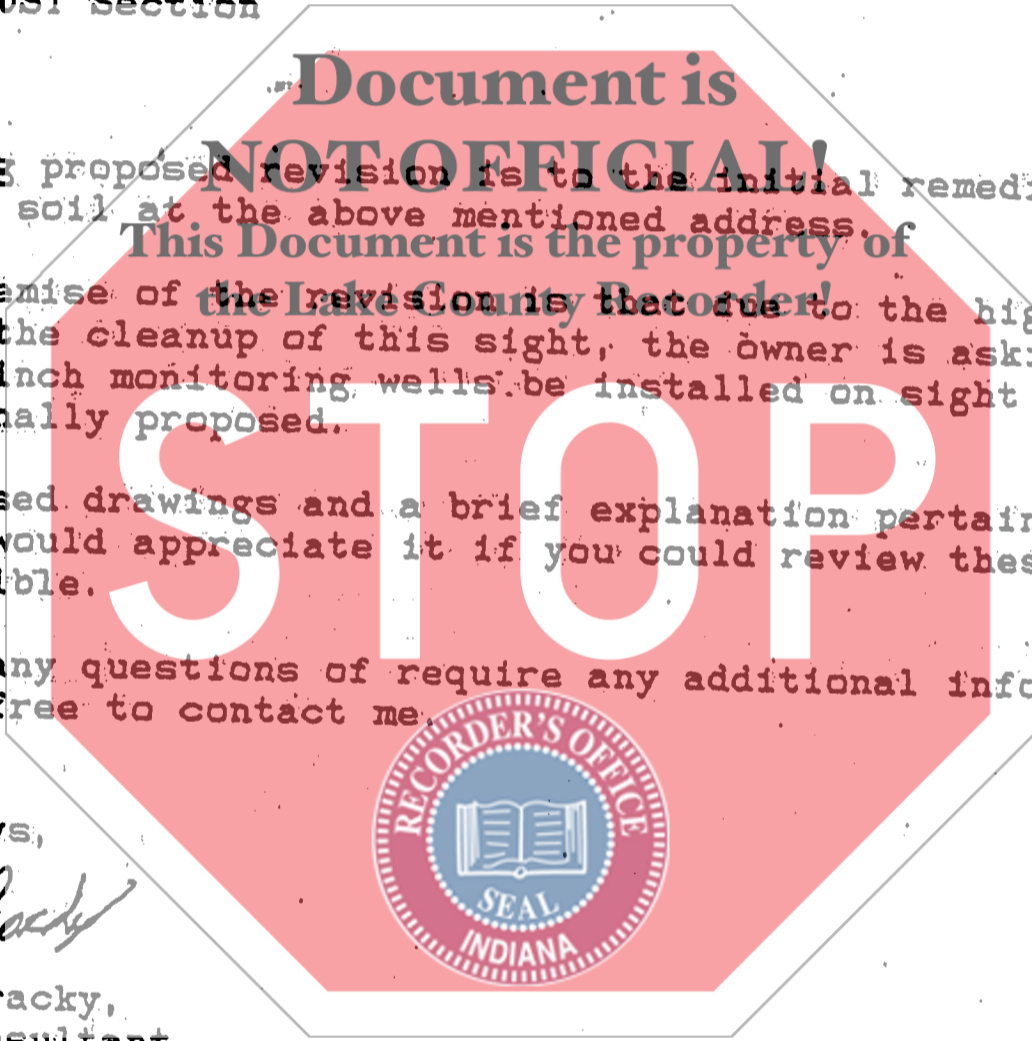


DIAGRAM # 1

Diagram # 1 shows the sight that were are dealing with. Both excavation areas have had all contaminated soil removed from the holes. Four (4) soil samples have been taken from each hole and are being analyzed for Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons against a diesel fuel scan. A copy of these analytical reports will be sent down with the final general sight assessment. A total of approximately 100 cubic yards of contaminated soil were removed from both holes and this material is being disposed of at LaPorte County Landfill, Michigan City, Indiana. Approximately 16,000 gallons of contaminated water was also removed from both of these holes using a skimming vacuum truck.

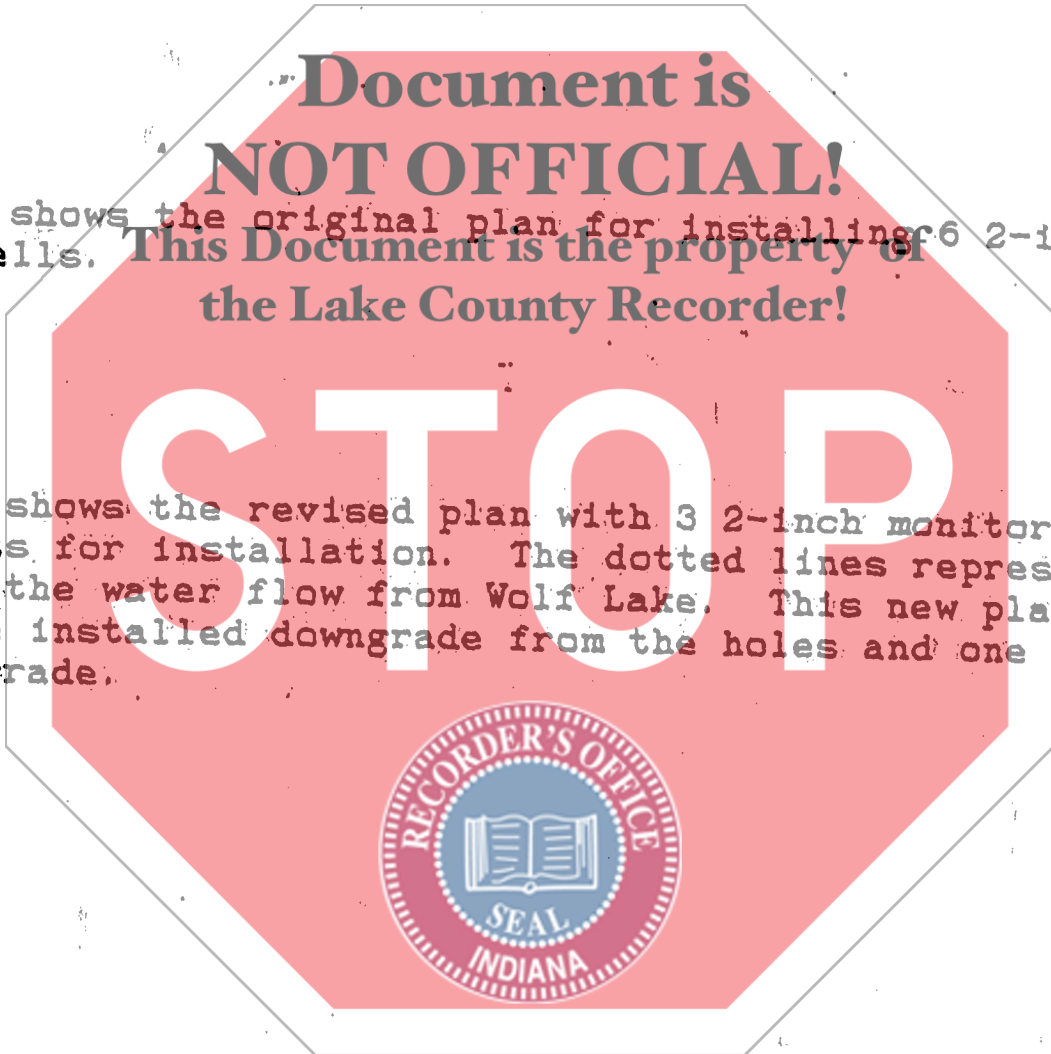
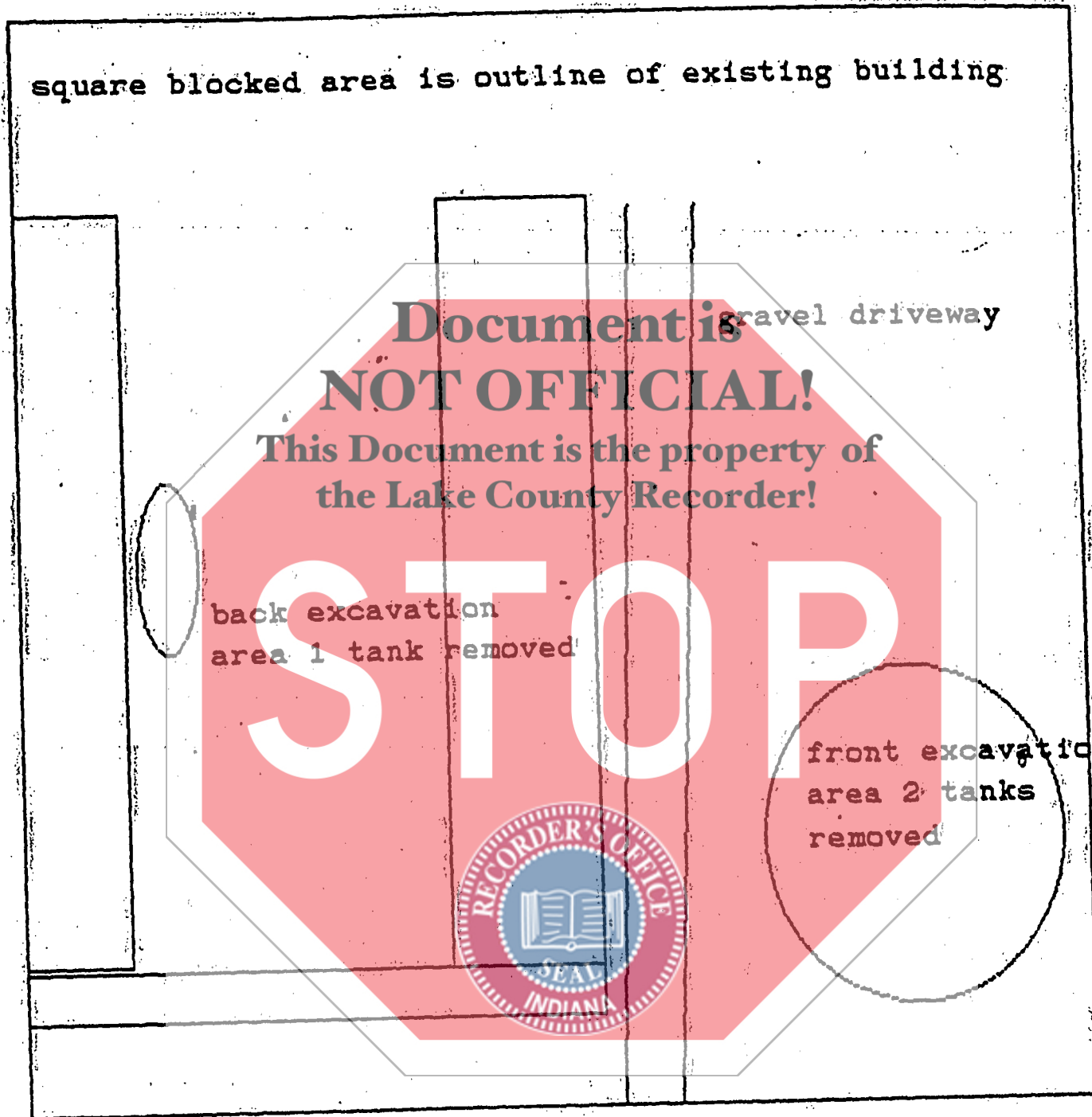

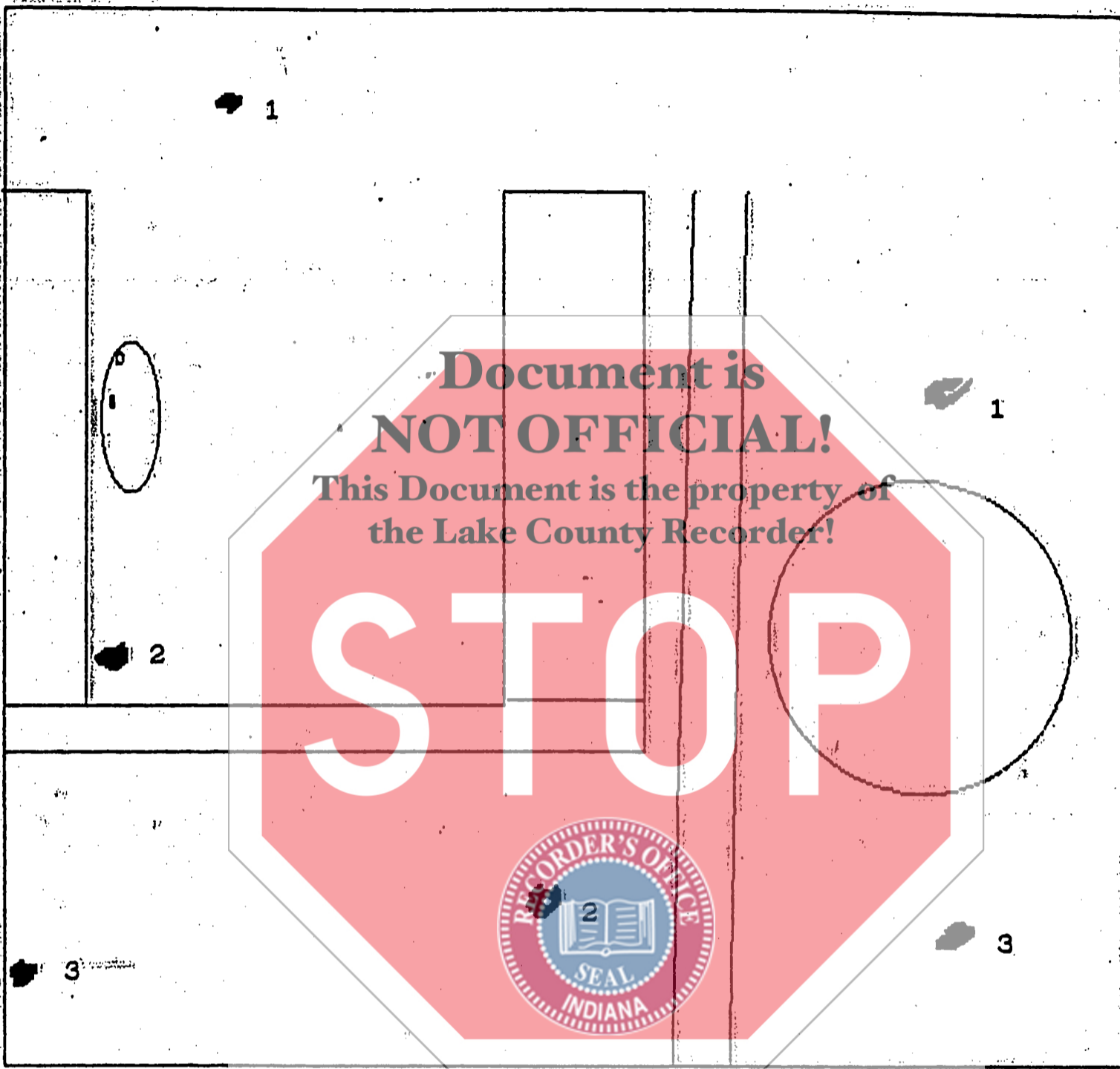

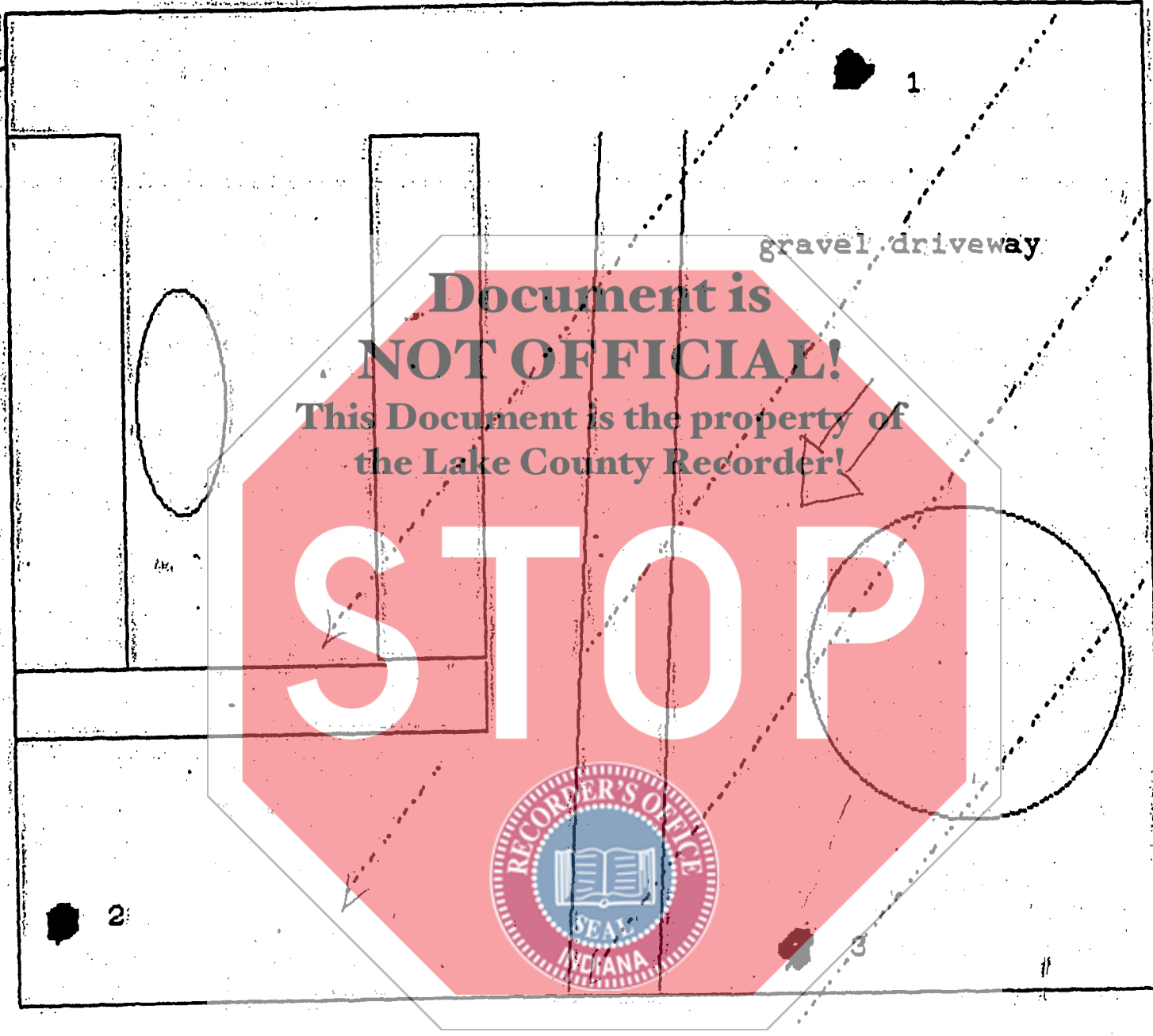
