RIGHT OF WAY EASEMENT

3 Huber Blvd

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration to

Fred Bloom Schinnerer and Georgie Ann Cheeseman

hereinafter referred to as Grantor, by Town of New Chicago hereinafter referred to as Grantee, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Grantor does hereby grant, bargain, sell, transfer, and convey unto the Grantee, its successors and assigns, a perpetual easement with the right to erect, construct, install, and lay, and thereafter use, operate, inspect, repair, maintain, replace, and remove and;

the parties hereby mutually agree that this will be a utility easement and that the grantees will not build any improvements other than the need for septic tank improvements and 4 inch lateral sewer from septic tank to collector sewer line over, across, and through the land of the Grantor which is Lake County, State of Indiana, said land being described as follows:
For location by plat, see drawings entitled New Chicago, Wastewater disposal Project, Wastewater Collection System, EPA No. C180-399-02, plan sheet, more particularly said land is a part of New Chicago Fifth Atl. West 17th Lot 17 Lot 18 Block 2 21-47-17

together with the right of ingress and egress over the adjacent lands of the Grantor, his successors and assigns, for the purposes of this easement.

This easement shall be 35' feet in length, the center line of which is described as follows: coinciding with the centerline of the 4" inch sewer lateral. The permanent easement shall be 10 feet wide with the centerline of the easement coinciding with the centerline of sewer lateral installed. Further, there shall be a 20-foot wide temporary easement during construction.

NOT OFFICIAL!

The consideration hereinabove recited shall constitute payment in full for any damages to the land of the Grantor, his successors and assigns by reason of the installation, operation and maintenance of the structures or improvements referred to herein. The Grantee covenants to maintain the easement in good repair so that no unreasonable damage will result from its use to the adjacent land of the Grantor, his successors and assigns.
