ORDER ON FINAL ACCOUNT AND DECREE OF FINAL DISTRIBUTION

This cause came on to be heard on the 16 day of Nov, 1990, upon the "Executor's Final Account and Petition to Settle and Allow, and for Authority to Distribute Estate", which is in the following words and figures to-wit:

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PRELIMINARY JURISDICTIONAL FINDINGS

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The Court thereupon examined the pertinent notices and proof thereof and now finds that:

1. Due notice of the qualification of such Executor and of the issuance thereto of Letters Testamentary was given as required by law.

2. That RAYMOND J. CONNELL, SR., died testate, a resident of the County of Lake, State of Indiana, on the 17th day of September, 1988 and his Last Will and Testament was duly admitted to probate before this Court on the 21st day of October, 1988, and this Court appointed said RAYMOND J. CONNELL, JR. as Executor of the Last Will and Testament of the Decedent, and said Executor was issued Letters Testamentary on the 21st day of October, 1988, and since that date he has continued to serve in such capacity.

3. More than five (5) months have elapsed since the date of the first published notice to creditors and other persons in the estate.

4. Due notice of the filing of such Final Account and of the hearing thereon was given to all persons interested in this Estate, as required by law.



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5. No objections to such Final Account have been filed.
6. Such Final Account is now ready for submission to the Court and for consideration thereof and action thereon by the Court.

FINDINGS OF FACT

Having examined and considered such Final Account and being duly advised, the Court now finds that:

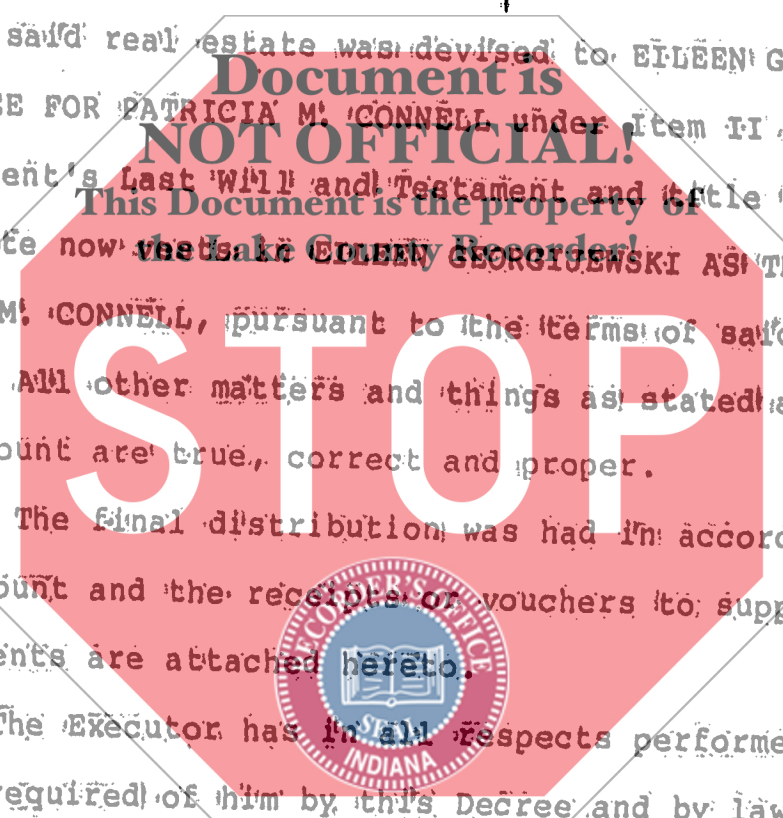
1. The amounts claimed as credits for attorney fees are just and reasonable for services rendered to date.
2. The Executor has accounted for all assets in the estate coming into his hands during the administration of the estate and for which he is chargeable by law.
3. The Indiana Inheritance Tax due by reason of the decedent's death has been paid.
4. No Federal Estate Tax or Indiana Estate Tax was due as a result of the decedent's death.
5. That any Federal or State income taxes owed by the decedent has been fully paid by the Executor. Neither the decedent nor his Executor was an employer of labor as that term is defined by the Indiana Employment Security Act and therefore there are no unpaid contributions, interests or penalties imposed by such act due from this decedent's estate.
6. All claims, including expenses of administration have been paid; there are no unsatisfied claims against the decedent's estate and all debts and other obligations of this decedent and his estate have been paid or discharged.
7. All of the assets of this decedent's estate have been fully administered upon.
8. The Executor of this estate, a legally competent adult, is RAYMOND J. CONNELL, JR.
9. The manner of distribution and disposition of this decedent's estate as proposed by the Proposed Distribution:

Schedule of the Final Account filed by the Executor herein is fair, equitable and reasonable and is in all respects correct and has been properly determined in accordance with the provisions of the laws of the State of Indiana.

10. That the decedent owned a parcel of real estate located at 2605 - 140th Place, East Chicago, Indiana, more particularly described as follows:

Lot No. 9 in Block 6 in the Sunnyside Addition to East Chicago, as per plat thereof recorded in Plat Book 15, Page 1, in the Office of the Recorder of Lake County, Indiana, *Key No. 30-570-9

and that said real estate was devised to EILEEN GEORGIJEWSKI AS TRUSTEE FOR PATRICIA M. CONNELL under Item II and Item III of the Decedent's Last Will and Testament and title to said described real estate now the Lake County Recorder's property of EILEEN GEORGIJEWSKI AS TRUSTEE FOR PATRICIA M. CONNELL, pursuant to the terms of said will.



11. All other matters and things as stated and shown in the final account are true, correct and proper.

12. The final distribution was had in accordance with the final account and the receipts or vouchers to support disbursements are attached hereto.

13. The Executor has in all respects performed and discharged the acts required of him by this Decree and by law and the Executor and his surety should be discharged.

14. The estate should be closed.

GENERAL CONCLUSIONS

The Court now concludes that such Final Account is correct and that the prayer therein should be granted in full.

DECREE

IT IS NOW THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that:

1. The Final Account is hereby in all respects approved, settled, allowed and confirmed.

2. The amounts claimed as credits for the payment of fees of the attorneys for services to date and for the normal expenses are hereby allowed and approved.

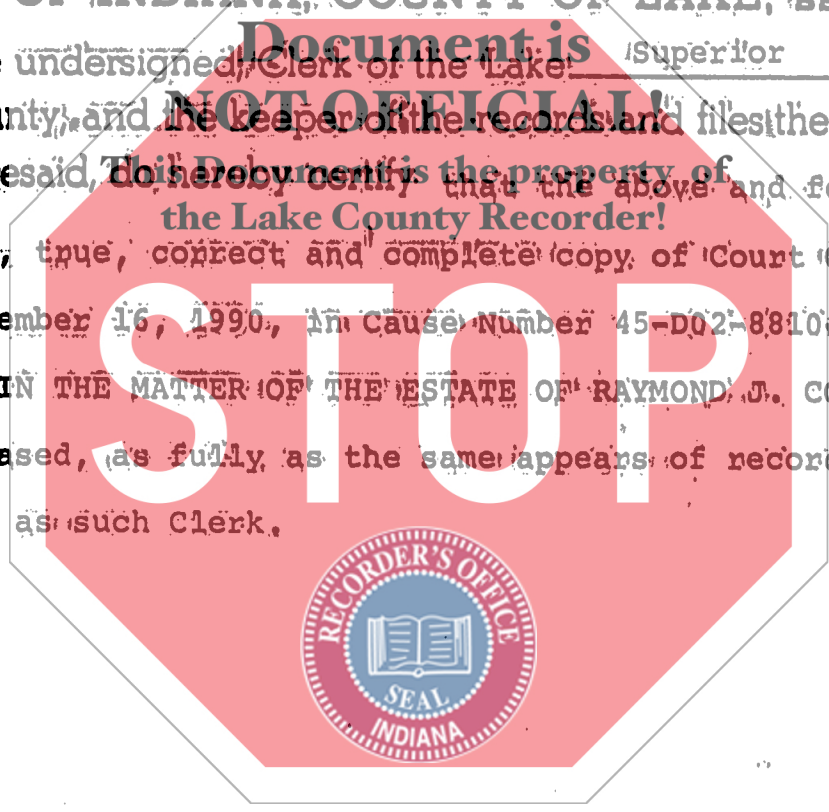
