KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, DUNELAND BUILDERS of the COUNTY of PORTER, State of INDIANA as Principal, and the CENTURY SURETY COMPANY, a corporation duly licensed to do business in the State of INDIANA as Surety, are held and firmly bound unto the COUNTY of LAKE State of INDIANA Oblige; in the penal sum of Five Thousand 00/100 (\$ 5,000) Dollars, lawful money of the United States, to be paid to the said Oblige, for which payment well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves and our legal representatives, jointly and severally by these presents:

THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION IS SUCH; That whereas, the said Principal has been licensed as a contractor by the said Oblige;

NOW, THEREFORE, If the said Principal shall faithfully perform the duties and in all things comply with the laws and ordinances, including all Amendments thereto, appertaining to the license or permit applied for, then this obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect for a period commencing on the 11 day of DECEMBER 19 90, unless renewed by continuation certificate.

This bond may be terminated at any time by the surety upon sending notice in writing to the clerk of the Political Subdivision with whom this bond is filed and to the Principal, addressed to them at the Political Subdivision named herein; and at the expiration of thirty-five (35) days from the mailing of said notice, this bond shall ipso facto terminate and the surety shall thereupon be relieved from any liability for any acts or omission of the Principal subsequent to said date.

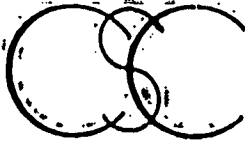

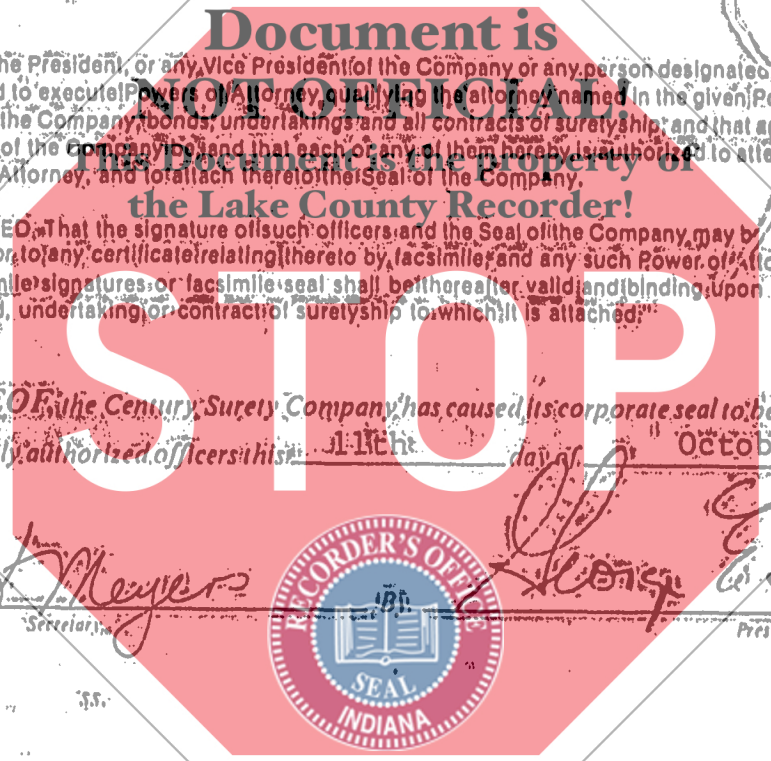
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That the Century Surety Company, organized and existing by virtue of the Laws of the State of Ohio does hereby nominate, constitute and appoint G. William Winey and Timothy C. Winey of Chesterton, in the state of Indiana its true and lawful attorney(s) in fact to make, execute, attest, seal and deliver for and on its behalf, as surety, and as its act and deed, where required, any and all bonds, undertakings, recognizances and written obligations in the nature thereof, the penal sum of no one of which is to exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00).

Such bonds and undertakings, when duly executed by the aforesaid Attorney(s) in fact shall be binding upon the said Company as fully and to the same extent as if such bonds and undertakings were signed by the President and Secretary of the Company and sealed with its corporate seal.

This Power of Attorney is granted and is signed by facsimile under and by the authority of the following Resolution adopted by the Board of Directors of the Company on the 11th day of August 1978.

"RESOLVED, That the President, or any Vice President of the Company or any person designated by any one of them is hereby authorized to execute Powers of Attorney, qualify as the attorney named in the given Power of Attorney to execute in behalf of the Company, bonds, undertakings and all contracts of suretyship, and that any Secretary or any Assistant Secretary of the Company be and that each or any of them hereby is authorized to attest the execution of any such Power of Attorney, and to attach thereto the Seal of the Company.

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the signature of such officers and the Seal of the Company may be affixed to any such Power of Attorney or to any certificate relating thereto by facsimile, and any such Power of Attorney or certificate bearing such facsimile signatures or facsimile seal shall be hereafter valid and binding upon the Company, with respect to any bond, undertaking or contract of suretyship to which it is attached.
