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## DECREE OF DISSOLUTION

Petitioner, MARY L. BERG, being in Court in person and by counsel, and respondent, LOUIS E. BERG, pro se, and this date being more than sixty (60) days from the date of filing of the Petition for Dissolution of Marriage, and the Court finding proper service of summons; therefore, the Court finds it appropriate that this cause of action be submitted on the Petition for Dissolution of Marriage.

The Court further finds that said Agreement was signed by both parties herein, was entered into fairly, without fraud, duress or undue influence; the provisions of that Agreement are equitable, and said Agreement should be approved by this Court, made a part of the Decree of Dissolution in this cause, and each of the parties is hereby bound by the same and should be ordered by this Court to fully carry out the terms of said Agreement.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Petitioner and the Respondent be, and they hereby are, dissolved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that the Agreement entered into between the parties, as specified in the findings of the Court, is hereby made a part of the Decree of Dissolution in this cause and that each of the parties is bound by the same, and each is hereby ordered by this Court to fully carry out the terms of said Agreement in accordance with the provisions thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that the wife's former name of RUDY be restored to her and that she now be known as MARY L. RUDY.
