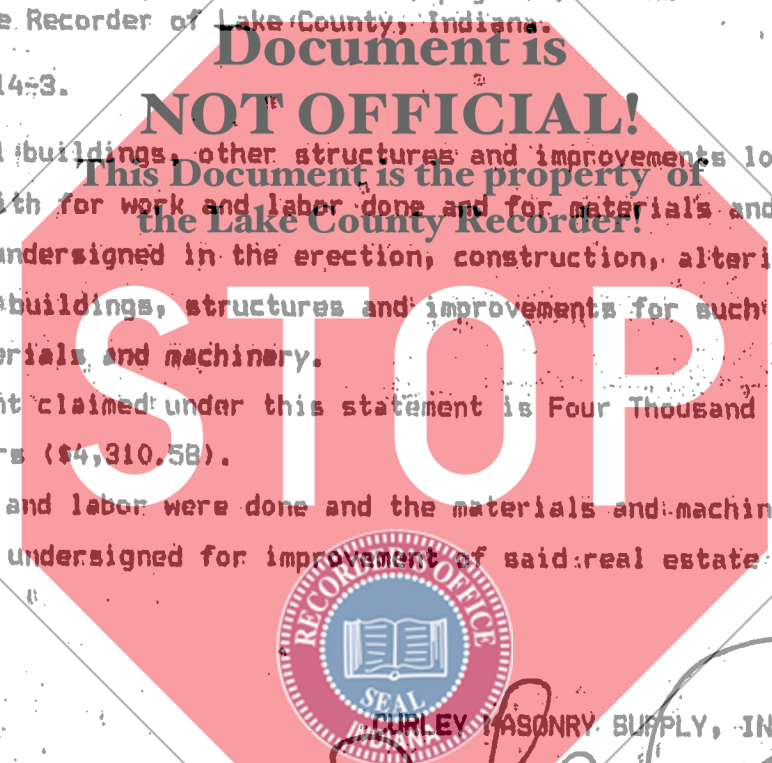

3. The work and labor were done and the materials and machinery were furnished by the undersigned for improvement of said real estate within the last sixty days.



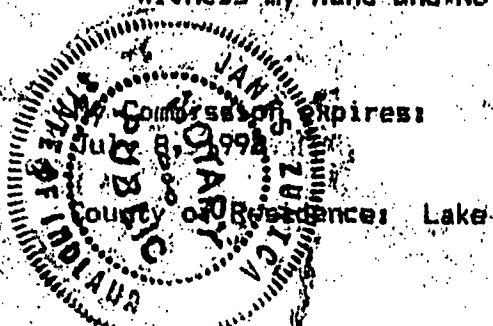
