I represent Mr. and Mrs. Gough regarding the lien you executed and caused to be recorded, the two contracts they have with your corporation for construction of their new home, and the damage you caused to the structure.

The lien was executed and recorded more than sixty days after you last provided work and on materials for which you liened. There are other matters that also make the lien invalid and unenforceable. As such, it is slander of title. Demand is made for you to release the firm immediately so as to terminate the slander. Failure to do so will subject you to damages for the slander of title which will include, but not be limited to increased costs of borrowing and bonding over the lien, increased costs incurred as to other subcontractors and delay.

Without waiving their claim for stander of title, my clients hereby demand that if you do not release the lien that you initiate suit to foreclose the lien and determine its legal validity within thirty days. If you fail to do so, your lien rights will be extinguished by operation of law.


While performing the backfilling, you damaged the foundation walls. Then you had the audacity to charge for some work associated with the repair, though you refused to make the repair. If you choose to sue on this lien, you will be counter sued for those damages.

Finally, when Mr. Gough contacted your corporation to schedule your performance under the plumbing contract, he was told that you would do no plumbing work or work under the plumbing contract until paid for the excavating work, for which you liened. My clients understand that to be your cancellation of the plumbing contract for which you have been paid \$5,500.00. Unless I hear from you in writing within ten days of the date of this letter how that understanding is incorrect, my clients with assume their understanding is correct.






