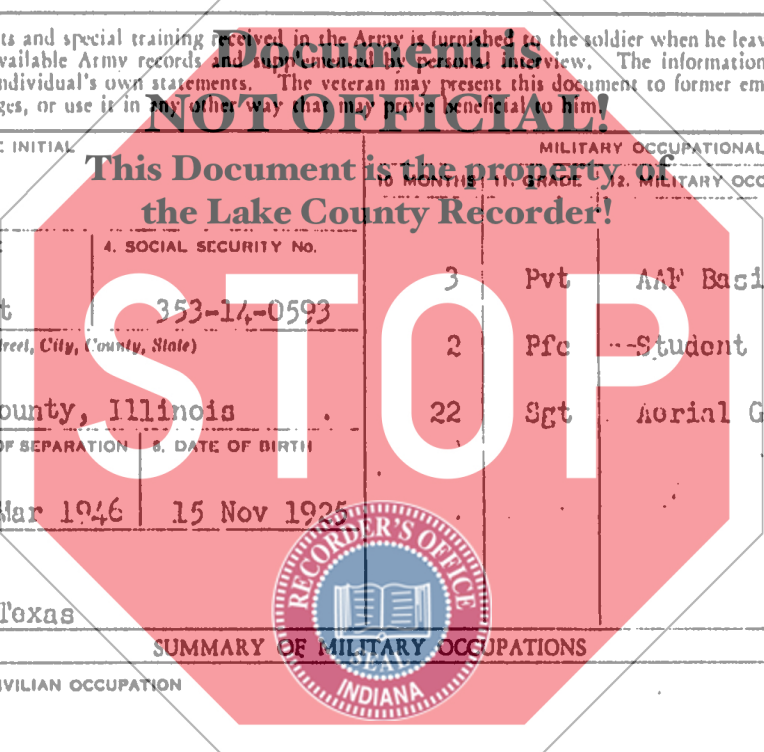


SEPARATION QUALIFICATION RECORD
