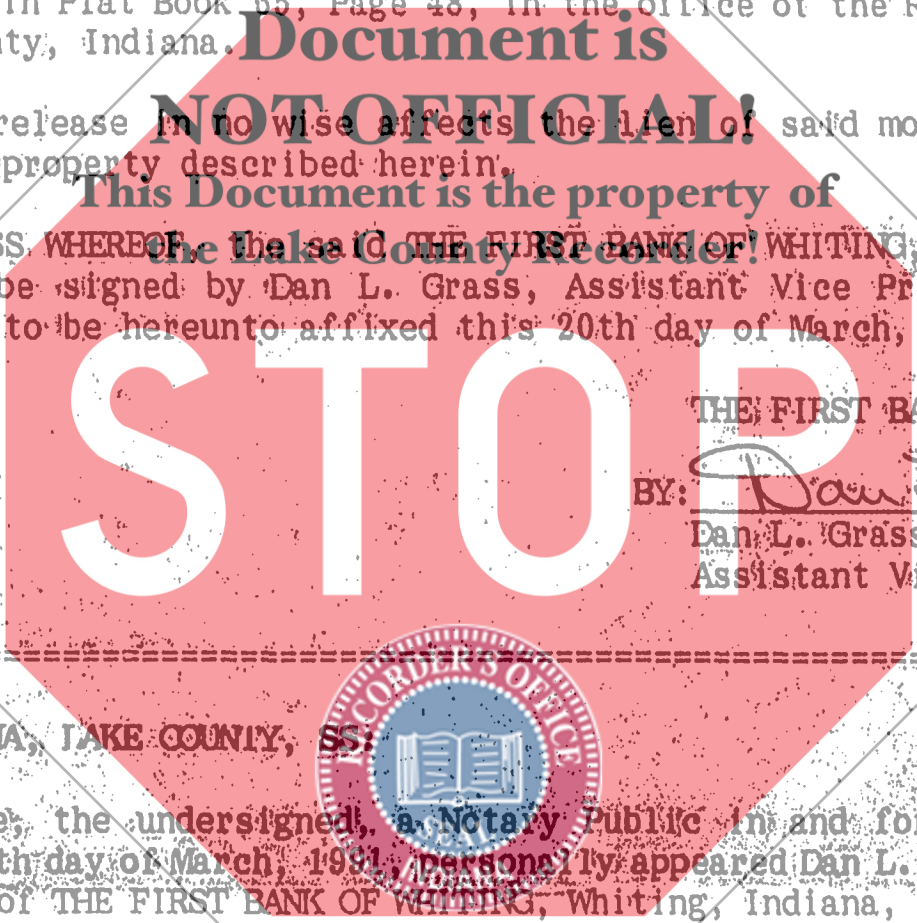
PARTIAL RELEASE OF MORTGAGE

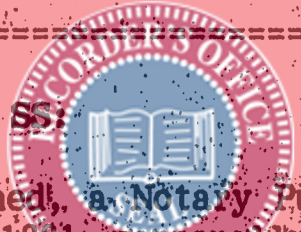
