AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF A RUBLIC ALLEY WESE OF AND STREET AND BETWEEN HIGHWAY AVENUE AND RIDGE ROAD IN THE TOWN OF HIGHLAND, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Highland, Lake County, Indiana, as follows:

Section 1. The Town Council does hereby find:

a. The petitioners Climer Fillayden and Delores R. Layden, d/b/a Highland Office Center, are the legal owners of the following described real estate:

Lots 5=10 The late way being the page 86, in the Office of the Recorder of Lake County, Indiana.

and

Lots 11-15 inclusive except the South 25 feet of Lot 15, Block 3, in the Original Town of Highland, as shown in Plat Book 1, page 86, in the Office of the Recorder of Lake County, Indiana.

- b. That said petitioners desire to develop and construct a laboratory building on Lots 13, 14 and 15 of said property on said real estate and are seeking a vacation of that portion of the public alley between Highway Avenue and Ridge Road, beginning at the west right of way line of 2nd Street and extending 275 feet westward, and adjoining Lots 6 through 10, Block 3, on the north and Lots 11 through 15, Block 3, on the south, which runs through part of the above described property.
- c. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Highland, Lake County, Indiana, that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage as required by law.
