

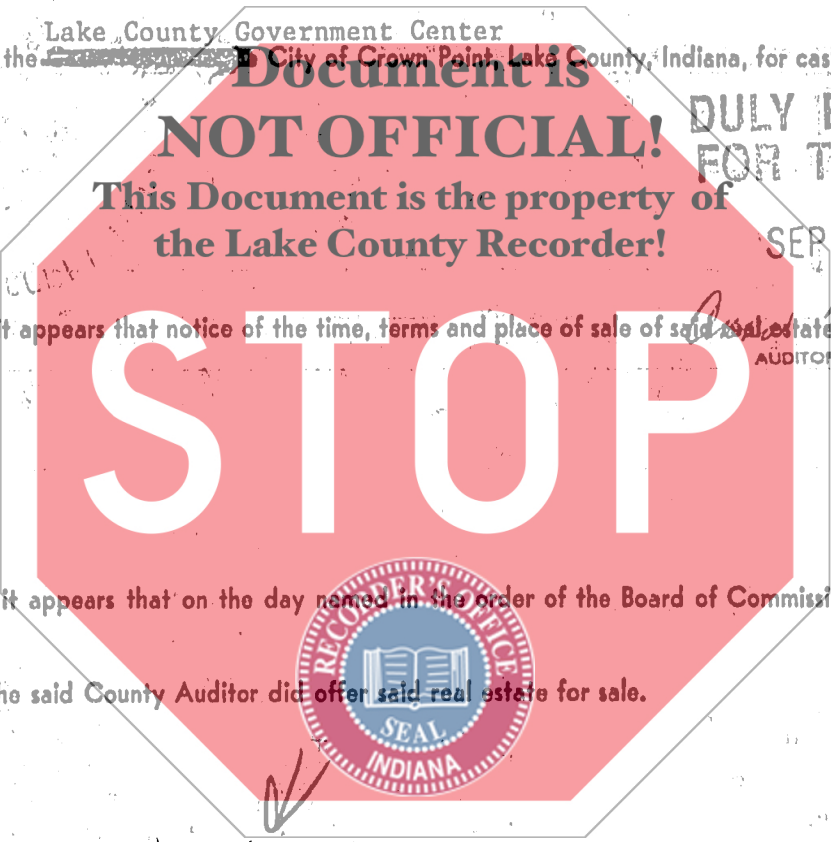

AND, WHEREAS, said property having not been redeemed, the Board of County Commissioners did on the 29th day of JUNE, 1987 at a regular meeting of said board, order that said parcels, lots and tracts of said real estate as hereinafter described, be sold by the County Auditor on the 12th day of AUGUST
