- 5. That the Inheritance tax due the State of Indiana as to said interest in real estate passing to the aforesaid devisees has been determined and paid.
- 6. That this affidavit is made to overcome any objection the Auditor of Lake County, Indiana, may have to record the deed of Elli Trappe dated May 8, 1991, whereby she conveys her interest in the aforesaid real estate to herself and Irene Elli Fritzke as

joint tenants with right of survivorship and not as tenants in common.
