5. That the Respondent is now incarcerated in the Michigan City State Prison, Michigan City, Indiana after having been convicted of murder and sentenced to forty (40) years in prison.

6. That the parties own real estate at 1133 Idaho, Gary, Indiana which real estate should be signed over to the Petitioner.

7. That in view of the fact that the Petitioner will, by necessity, have to pay all of the outstanding debts of the parties, the Petitioner should be awarded all property of the parties.

8. That the Respondent Sylvester Brown is not now a member of the armed forces and Affidavit of Non-Military Service is filed herein.

hereby restored to the status of single persons.

3. The Petitioner is awarded the custody the parties' minor child, SYLVESTER GERARD BROWN, born May 1, 1979. The Court withholds any visitation rights at this time until said Respondent presents himself to the Court to explain how he could exercise visitation rights.

4. Because the Petitioner is going to be forced, by necessity, to pay all the outstanding debts of the parties and to raise the child without economic support, the Court hereby vests all right, title and interest in all properties of the parties wherever situated or located in the name of Petitioner and divests same from the Respondent. The Court hereby appoints Elva Redign as a Commissioner to sign all deed necessary to transfer the property at 1133 Idaho, Gary, Indiana which has a legal description as follows:

Aetna Securities Company's First Sub all of Lot 15, Block 6. and any other documents necessary to transfer any property to the Petitioner.
