And it appearing that no objections were filed thereto and the Court being fully advised in the premises now finds that:

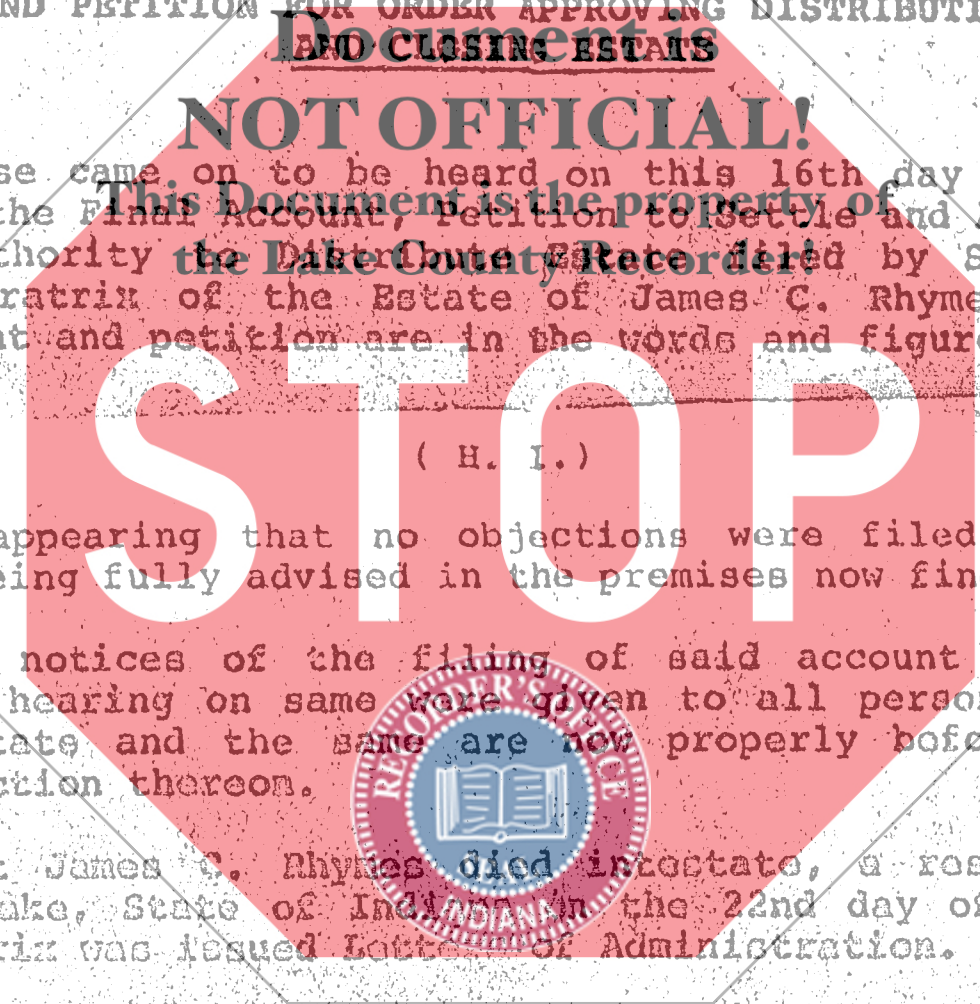
1. Due notices of the filing of said account and petition and of the hearing on same were given to all persons interested in said estate and the same are now properly before the Court for final action thereon.

2. That James C. Rhymes died intestate, a resident of the County of Lake, State of Indiana, in the 22nd day of June, 1976, administratrix was issued Letters of Administration.

3. That the matters and things stated in said account and petition are true, and that the said administratrix has accounted for all the assets in this estate coming into her hands.

4. More than five (5) months have elapsed since the date of the first (1st) published notice to the heirs and creditors of said decedent. All claims filed against the estate have been paid and discharged; neither said decedent nor his administratrix were employers of labor within the meaning of that term as used in the Indiana Employment Security Act; all estate taxes, inheritance taxes and gross income taxes, if any, assessed in said estate have been paid.

6. That the decedent owned a certain piece of real estate located at 2120 Front Street, in the City of Gary, County of Lake, State of Indiana, more particularly described as follows:
