WHEREAS, the Airport Authority Board determined it to be in the best interests of the community to designate the airport as Gary Regional Airport and changed the official name of the airport to Gary Regional Airport at its November 14, 1989 board meeting; and This Document is the property of

WHEREAS, the Board also desires to change its name to Gary Regional Airport Authority,

NOW, Therefore, be it resolved by the Board of Gary Municipal Airport Authority that:

- 1. The name of Gary Municipal Airport Authority be changed, effective on the 28th day of May, 1991, to Gary Regional Airport Authority;
- The Acting Airport Director, Lavell Gatewood, is directed to file a certified copy of this resolution, upon adoption, in the miscellaneous Records of the Recorder of Lake County, Indiana;
- The Acting Airport Director, Lavell Gatewood, is directed to forward a certified copy of this resolution, upon adoption, to the Indiana Department of Transportation and to the Federal Aviation Administration; and
- 4. All existing rights and obligations of Gary Municipal Airport Authority shall hereafter be assumed and accepted in the name of Gary Regional Airport Authority and the Board resolves to take all actions consistent therewith.
