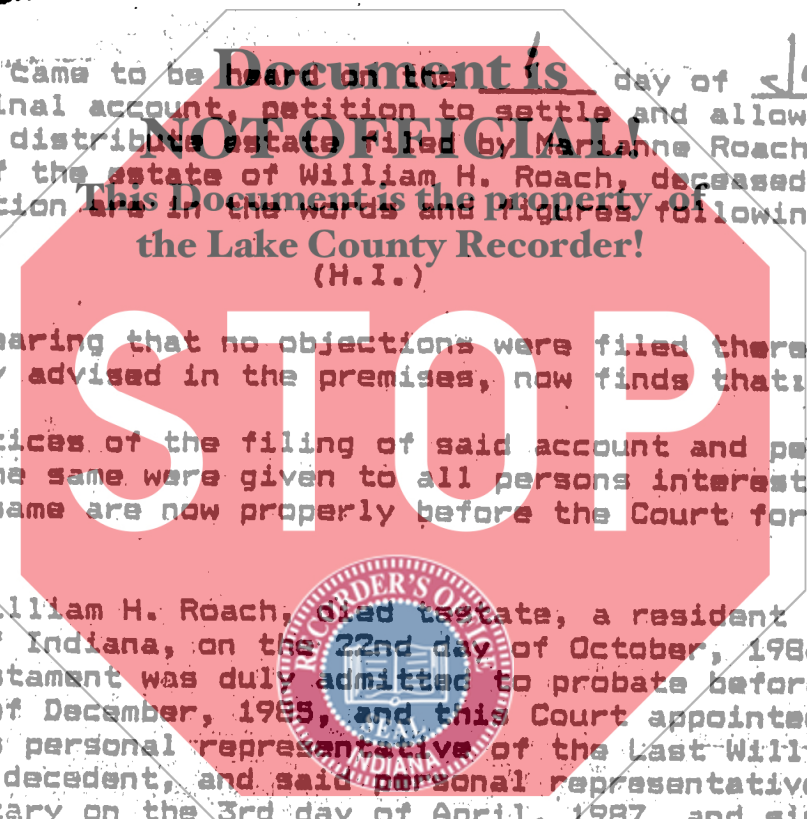

ORDER APPROVING PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE'S  
FINAL REPORT AND ACCOUNTING, PETITION FOR  
ACCOUNTING, PETITION FOR ORDER APPROVING  
DISTRIBUTION AND CLOSING ESTATE

This cause came to be heard on the 1st day of June,  
1990, upon the final account, petition to settle and allow account and  
for authority to distribute estate filed by Marianne Roach, as personal  
representative of the estate of William H. Roach, deceased, which  
account and petition are in the words and figures following, to-wit:

And it appearing that no objections were filed thereto and the  
Court being fully advised in the premises, now finds that:

1. Due notices of the filing of said account and petition and of  
the hearing on the same were given to all persons interested in said  
estate, and the same are now properly before the Court for final action  
thereon.

2. That William H. Roach, decedent, a resident of the County  
of Lake, State of Indiana, on the 22nd day of October, 1986, and his  
Last Will and Testament was duly admitted to probate before this Court  
on the 17th day of December, 1985, and this Court appointed said  
Marianne Roach as personal representative of the Last Will and  
Testament of the decedent, and said personal representative was issued  
Letters Testamentary on the 3rd day of April, 1987, and since that date  
she has continued to serve in such capacity.

3. That the matters and things stated in said account and  
petition are true and that said personal representative has accounted  
for all of the assets in this estate coming into her hands.

4. More than five (5) months have elapsed since the date of the  
first published notice to legates, devisees, and creditors of said  
decedent; all claims filed against said estate have been paid and  
discharged; neither said decedent nor his personal representative were  
employers of labor within the meaning of that term as used in the  
Indiana Employment Security Act; all estate taxes, inheritance taxes  
and gross income taxes, if any, assessed for taxation on said estate have been paid.

5. The following persons are the sole legatees and devisees under the decedent's Last Will and Testament:

and that all assets and property of this estate remaining after payment of decedent's debts and expenses of administration has been distributed to the above-named person, as assets were available:

Leaving an unpaid portion of \$2,000.00 due Christopher Roach and Alvin Roach did not receive a legacy of \$1,000.00 because of a lack of funds.

6. That the decedent owned a certain piece of real estate as joint tenants with right of survivorship, and said real estate upon the death of the decedent vested in the surviving joint tenants. In addition, decedent owned a certain piece of real estate located at 4600 E. 10th Avenue, Gary, Lake County, Indiana, more particularly described as follows:

The West 10 feet of Lot 19 in Block 25 in Aetna Securities Company's Second Subdivision, as per plat thereof, recorded in Plat Book 20 page 39, in the Office of the Recorder of Lake County, Indiana. Also the East 30 feet of vacated Benton Street lying West and adjoining said part of Lot 19. Key No. 41-29-21.

and that said real estate, valued at \$1,000.00 after a fire, would have passed to Marianne Roach, as residuary legatee had there been sufficient assets in the estate, however, as the estate lacked sufficient assets to pay decedent's obligations it is requested that said real estate be transferred to Marianne Roach, individually, as reimbursement for cash advanced by her, personally, to pay decedent's obligations.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court as follows:

1. Said Final Report and Account of said personal representative is hereby in all things approved, settled and confirmed.
2. That the distribution of the balance of the property remaining in said personal representative's hands for distribution has been made pursuant to the distribution set forth in the final accounting as prescribed under the Last Will and Testament of said decedent and is hereby in all things approved.

to the following described real estate:

The West 10 feet of Lot 19 in Block 25 in Aetna Securities Company's Second Subdivision, as per plat thereof, recorded in Plat Book 20 page 39, in the Office of the Recorder of Lake County, Indiana. Also the East 30 feet of vacated Benton Street lying West and adjoining said part of Lot 19. Key No. 41-29-21.

the proceeds of a sale of said real estate by the executrix in the amount of approximately \$1,000.00 shall be transferred to her, individually, and if there is no such sale then title is hereby vested in Marianne Roach, individually, as reimbursement for cash advanced by her, personally, to pay decedent's obligations.

4. Said personal representative having made distribution of all assets and property to said legatees and devisees, as stated aforesaid, said distribution is hereby approved and confirmed.

5. Said personal representative is hereby released and discharged from any further liability or responsibility along with her surety as said personal representative of the estate of William H. Roach.

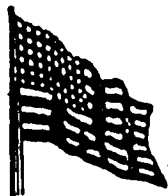
