TOGETHER, with all appurtenances thereto and all the estate and rights of the Mortgagor in and to such property or in anywise appertaining thereto; all buildings and other structures now or hereafter thereon erected or installed, and all fixtures and articles of personal property now or hereafter attached to, or used in, or in the operations of, any such land, buildings or structures which are necessary to the complete use and occupancy of such buildings or structures for the purpose for which they were or are to be erected or installed, including, but not limited to all heating, plumbing, bathroom, lighting, cooking, laundry, ventilating, refrigerating, incinerating, and uir-conditioning equipment and fixtures and all replacements thereof and additions thereto, whether or not the same are or shall be attached to such land, buildings or structures in any manner:

The Mortgagor will pay when due, as hereinaster provided, all ground rents, if any, and all taxes, assessments, water rates and other governmental charges, fines and impositions, of every kind and nature whatsoever, now or hereafter imposed on the mortgaged property, or any part thereof, and will pay when due every amount of indebtedness secured by any lien to which the lien of this Mortgage is expressly subject.
- 3. This Mortgage and the Note were executed and delivered to secure moneys advanced, or to be advanced; by the Mortgagee as or on account of a loan evidenced by the Note, for the purpose of making the improvements described or redated 8/24-8/20-9/12 , 19\*91 , to or on the mortgaged property, and ferred to in the Specifications for such other purpose, if any, described or referred to therein, which improvements are hereafter collectively called "Im-

Improvements!". The Mortgagor shall make or cause to be made all the Improvements. If the construction or installation of the Improvements shall not be carried out with reasonable diligence, or shall be discontinued attany time for any reason, other than strikes, lockouts, acts of God, fires, floods or other similar catastrophies, riots, war or insurrection, the Mortgagoe after due notice to the Mortgagor is hereby authorized (a) to enter upon the mortgaged property and employ any watchmen to protect the Improvements from depredation or injury and to preserve and protect such property, (b) to carry outlany or all their existing contracts between the Mortgagor and other parties for the purpose of making any of the Improvements, (c) to make and enter into additional contracts and incur obligations for the purposes of completing the Improvements pursuantitio the obligations of the Mortgagor hereunder, either in the name of the Mortgage or the Mortgagor, and (d) to pay and discharge all debts, obligations and liabilities incurred by reason of any action taken by the Mortgagee, as provided in this Paragraph, all of which amounts so paid by the Mortgagee shall be payable by the Mortgagor to the Mortgagee on demand and shall be secured by this Mortgage; provided, however, that the Mortgagee shall not be required to perform any act so authorized.

- 4. No building or other structure or improvement, fixture or personal property mortgaged hereby shall be removed or demolished without the prior written consent of the Mortgagee. The Mortgagor will not make, permit or suffer any alteration of or addition to any building or other structure or improvement now or which may hereafter be erected or installed upon the mortgaged property, or any part thereof, except the improvements required to be made pursuant to Paragraph 3 hereof, nor will the Mortgagor use, or permit or suffer the use of, any of the mortgaged property for any purpose, other than the purpose or purposes for which the same is now intended to be used, without the prior written consent of the Mortgagor will maintain the mortgaged property in good condition and state of repair and will not suffer or permit any, wastes to any part thereof, and will promptly comply with all the requirements of Federal, state and localing overnments, or of any departments, divisions or bureaus thereof, pertaining to such property or any part thereof.

(a) The Mortgagor will keep all buildings, other structures and improvements, including equipment, now existing or which may hereafter be detected existalled on the hand mortgaged thereby, insured against loss by fire and other hazards, casualties and coordingencies, in such amounts and manner, and for such periods, all as may be required from time to time by the Mortgagee. Unless otherwise required by the Mortgagee, all such insurance shall be effected by Standard Fire and Extended) Coverage Insurance spolicies, in amounts not less than necessary to comply with the coinsurance clause percentage of the value applicable to the location and character of the property to be covered. All such insurance shall be carried in companies approved by the Mortgagee and all policies therefor, shall be in such form and shall have attached thereto loss payable clauses in favor of the Mortgagee and any other parties as shall be satisfactory to the Mortgagee. In the event of foreclosure of this Mortgage, or of any transfer of title to the mortgaged property in extinguishment of such indebtedness, all right, title and interest of the Mortgagor in and to every such insurance policy them in force, subject to the rights and interests of the holder of any such prior lien, shall pass to the grantee acquiring title to the mortgaged property together with such policy and appropriate assignment of such right; title and interest which shall be made by the Mortgagor.

- 7. The Improvements and all plans and specifications therefor shall comply with all applicable municipal ordinances, regulations, and rules made or promulgated by lawful authority, and upon their completion shall comply therewith.
- 8. Upon any failure by the Mortgagor to comply with or perform any of the terms, covenants or conditions of this Mortgagor requiring the payment of any amount of money by the Mortgagor, other than the principal amount of the loan evidenced by the Note; interest and other charges, as provided in the Note, the Mortgagee may at its option make such payment. Every payment so made by the Mortgagee (including reasonable attorney's fees incurred thereby), with interest thereon from the date of such payment, at the rate of the payment (18%) per annum, except any payment for which a different rate of interest is specified herein, shall be payable by the Mortgagor to the Mortgagee on demand and shall be secured by this Mortgage. This Mortgage with respect to any such amount and the interest thereon, shall constitute a lien on the mortgaged property prior to any other lien attaching or accruing subsequent to the lien of this Mortgage.
- 9. The Mortgagee, by any of its agents or representatives, shall have the right to inspect the mortgaged property from time to time at any reasonable hour of the day. Should the mortgaged property, or any part thereof, at any time require inspection, repair, care or attention of any kind or nature not provided by this Mortgage as determined by the Mortgagees in its sole discretion, the Mortgagee may, after notice to the Mortgagor, enter or cause entry to be made upon, the mortgaged property, and inspect, repair, protect, care for or maintain such property, as the Mortgagee may in its sole discretion deem processary, and may pay all amounts of money therefor, as the Mortgagee may in its sole discretion deem processary, and may pay all amounts of money therefor, as the Mortgagee may in its sole discretion.

The Mortgagee is authorized to declare, at its option, all or any part of such indebtedness immediately due and payable upon the happening of any of the following events: Failure to pay the amount of any payment, or other charges payable on the Note; or the occurrence of any circumstance by which the entire remaining balance of the Note by its terms is immediately due and payable. (b) Nonperformance by the Mortgagor of any covenant, agreement, term or condition of this Mortgage, or of the Note (except as otherwise provided in subdivision (a) hereof) or of any other agreement heretofore, herewith or hereafter made by the Mortgagor with the Mortgagee in connection with such indebtedness; Failure of the Mortgagor to perform any covenant, agreement; term of condition in any instrument creating allien upon the mortgaged property; or any part thereof, which shall have priority over the lien of this Mortgage; (d) The Mortgagee's discovery of the Mortgagor's failure in any application of the Mortgagor to the Mortgagee to disclose any fact deemed by the Mortgagee to be material; or of the making therein or in any of the agreements entered into by the Mortgagor with the Mortgagee (including, but not limited to, the Note and this Mortgage) of any misrepresentation by, on behalf of, or for the benefit of, the Mortgagor; The sale, lease or other transfer of any kind or nature of the mortgaged property, or any part thereof, without the prior written consent of the Mortgagee; The enactment after, the date of this Mortgage of any law of the State of Indiana deducting from the value of the mortgaged property (or any part thereof), for the purpose of taxation, any lien thereon, or changing in any way its laws for the taxation of mortgages or debts secured by mortgage for state or local purposes; or the manner of collection of any such tax, so as to affect this Mortgage, and if after such enactment or change the holder of the Note and this Mortgage gives written notice to the Mortgage declaring the Note and all the indebted estimates the Mortgage to be due and payable, because of any such enactment or change, immediately upon the expiration of thirty (3D) days after such notice. (g) Impairment or deterioration of the mortgaged premises or any improvement thereon, or waste committed or permitted by the Mortgagorin regarding the mortgaged premises thany improvement the con. The Mortgagee's failure to exercise any of its rights hereunder shall not constitute a waiver thereof. All the events in this Paraagraph enumerated upon the happening of any of which the Note shall become, or may be declared to be, immediately due and payable, are in this Mortgage called "events of default". 11. The Mortgagee may from time to time cure each default under any covenant or agreement in any instrument creating a lien upon the mortgaged property, or any part thereof, which shall have priority over the lien of this Mortgage; to such extent as the Mortgagee may exclusively determine; and each amount paid (if any) by the Mortgagee to cure any such default shall be paid by the Mortgagor to the Mortgagee; and the Mortgagee shall also become subrogated to whatever rights the holder of the prior lien might have under such instrument. 12. (a) After the happening of any default heraunder, the Mortgager shall upon demand of the Mortgager surrender possession of the mortgaged property to the Mortgager, and the Flortgager may enter such property, and let the same and collect all the rents therefrom which are due or to become due, and apply the same, after payment of all charges and expenses, on account of the indebtedness hereby secured, and all such rents and all leases existing at the time of such default are hereby assigned to the Mortgagee as further security for the payment of the indebtedness secured hereby; and the Mortgagee may also dispossess, by the usual summary proceedings, any tenant defaulting in the payment of any rent to the Mortgagee. (b) In the event that the Mortgagor occupies the mortgaged property or any part thereof, the Mortgagor agrees to surrender possession of such property to the Mortgagee immediately after any such default hereunder, and if the Mortgagor remains in possession after such default, such possession shall be as a tenant of the Mortgagee, and the Mortgagor shall pay in advance, upon demand by the Mortgagee, as a reasonable monthly rental for the premises occupied by the Mortgagor, an amount at least equivalent to 1/60th of the original principal sum of the Note, plus the actual amount of the annual ground rent, if any, taxes, assessments, water rates, other governmental charges and insurance premiums payable in connection with the mortgaged property during such year, and upon the failure of the Morgagor to pay such monthly rental, the Mortgagor may also be dispossessed by the usual summary proceedings applicable to tenants. This covenant shall become effective immediately upon the happening of any such default, as determined in the sole discretion of the Mortgagee, who shall give notice of such determination to the Mortgagor; and in the case of foreclosure and the appointment of a receiver of the rents, the within covenant shall inure to the benefit of such receiver. This provision shall not affect Morigagee's rights to foreclose this mortgage or to payment of the amounts secured hereby. 13. The Mortgagee in any action to foreclose this Mortgage shall be entitled to the appointment of a receiver without notice, as a matter of right and without regard to the value of the mortgaged property, or the solvency or insolvency of the Mortgagor or other party liable for the payment of the Note and other indebtedness secured by this Mortgage. 14. The Mortgagor, within ten (10) days upon request in person or within twenty (20) days upon request by mail, will sumish promptly a written statement in form satisfactory to the Mortgagee, signed by the Mortgagor and duly acknowledged, of the amount then owing on the Note and other indebtedness secured by this Mortgage, and whether any offsets or defenses exist against such indebtedness or any part thereof. 15. The Mortgagor will give immediate notice by registered or cartified mail to the Mortgagee of any fire, damage or other casualty affecting the mortgaged property, or of any conveyance, transfer or change in ownership of such property, or any part thereof. 16. Notice and demand or request may be made in writing and may be served in person or by mail.

This Mortgage and all the covenants, agreements, terms and conditions herein contained shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the Mortgagor and the heirs, legal representatives and assigns of the Mortgagor, and, to the extent permitted by law, every subsequent owner of the mortgaged property; and shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the Mortgagee and its assigns. If the Mortgagor, as defined herein, consists of two or more parties, this Mortgage shall constitute a grant and mortgage by all of them jointly and severally, and they shall be obligated jointly and severally under all the provisions hereof and under the Note. The word "Mortgagee" shall include any person, corporation or other party who may from time to time be the holder of this Mortgage. Wherever used herein the singular number shall include the plural number shall include the singular, and the use of any gender shall be applicable to all genders wherever the sense requires.
- 21. Mortgagor shall not commit, suffer or permit any impairment or deterioration of the mortgaged property or any improvement thereon, and shall maintain the mortgaged property and all improvements thereon in good condition and repair. Mortgagor will not commit or permit any-waste, and will keep the mortgaged premises in as good order, and condition as they now are, reasonable wear and test excepted. In the event that Mortgagor shall not comply with the obligations heretofore stated in this paragraph, then Mortgagee, in addition to any other available remedy, shall be entitled immediately to restrain same by injunction or other appropriate proceeding.
- 22. In addition to any monthly or other payment to be made pursuant to the Note affached as Exhibit "A"; at Mortgagee's option, Mortgagor shall pay to the Mortgagee on the same date as each installment payment provided for by Exhibit. "A", or if no installment payment is therein specified then on the 15th day of each month, beginning with the month immediately following that in which this mortgage is signed by Mortgagor an amount equal to the sum of one-twelfth of the annual real estate taxes on the property and one-twelfth of the annual premium for property damage insurance, for said property as said sum may be increased or decreased from time to time by increase or decrease in real estate taxes and/or insurance premium. Said payments shall be deposited by Mortgagee in a non-interest bearing account and applied by Mortgagee to payment of real estate taxes and insurance premiums as the same shall fall due.



## 23. Additional Events of Default and Remedies Therefor:

Section 23.1. Events of Default. The occurrence and continuance of any of the following events shall constitute an "event of default" hereunder:

- (d) Failure of the OWNER to perform or observe any convenant, condition or provision contained in this MORTGAGE on its part to be performed or observed and any such failure shall, remain unremedied for Childy (10) Stays after written notice thereof shall have been given to the OWNER by the CITY; or
- (e) The lien and security interest in The Project created by the MORTGAGE or financing statement shall for any reason cease to be in full forcebeand of Eccunty valuable perfected, subordinate only to Permitted Encumbrances; or

Any sale by the CITY may nevertheless, at its option, be made at such other place or places, and in such other manner, as may now or hereafter be authorized by law.

Section 23.2. Receipt Sufficient Discharge for Purchaser. The receipt of the CITY or of the court officer conducting any such sale for the purchase money paid at any such sale shall be a sufficient discharge therefor to any purchaser of the property, or any part thereof, sold as aforesaid; and no such purchaser or his representatives, grantees or assigns, after paying such purchase money and receiving such receipt, shall be bound to see to the application of such purchase money upon or for the purpose of this MORTCAGE, or shall be answerable in any manner whatsoever for any loss, misapplication of any such purchase money or any part thereof, nor shall any such purchaser be bound to inquire as to the necessity or expediency of any such sale.

Section 23.3. Document is the property of Sale. The purchase money proceeds of cheavakes Country Renander the there with any other sums which then may be held by the CITY under this MORTGAGE as part of The Project or the proceeds thereof, whether under the provisions of this Article or otherwise, shall be paid to the CITY who shall apply such funds as follows:

FIRST: To the payment of the costs and expenses of such sale, including reasonable compensation to the CITY, its agents, attorneys and counsel, and the expenses of any judicial proceedings wherein the same may be made, and of all expenses, liabilities and advances made or incurred by the CITY as permitted by this MORTGAGE, and to the payment of all taxes, assessments or liens prior to the lien of this MORTGAGE, except any taxes, assessments liens, or other charges, subject to which the property shall have been sold.

SECOND: To the payment of the whole amount of the

THIRD: To the payment of any other sums required to be paid by the OWNER pursuant to any provisions of the MORTGAGE.

FOURTH: To the payment of the surplus, if any, to the OWNER or its successors or assigns, upon the written request of the OWNER or to whomsoever may be lawfully entitled to receive the same upon its written request, or as any court of competent jurisdiction may direct.

Section 23.4. Appointment of Receiver. The OWNER further covenants that upon the happening of any Event of Default and thereafter during the continuance of such Event of Default unless the same shall have been waived as hereinbefore provided, the CITY shall be entitled as a matter of right if it shall so elect at any time to the appointment of a receiver or receivers of The Project and of all the earnings, revenues, rents, issues, profits and income thereof, with such powers as the court making such appointment shall confer, which may comprise any or all of the powers which the CITY is authorized to exercise. The OWNER, Is requested so to do by the CITY, will consent to the appointment of any such receiver as aforesaid.

Section 23.5. Remedies Cummulative. No remedy herein conferred upon or reserved to the CFTY is intended to be exclusive of any other remedy or remedies, and each and every such remedy shall be cumulative, and shall be in addition to every other remedy given hereunder, or now or hereafter existing at law or in equity or by statute.

Section 23.6. Delay or Omission Not a Waiver. No delay or omission of the CLTY to exercise any right or power accruing upon any event of default shall impair any such right or power, or shall be construed to be a waiver of any such event of default or any acquiescence therein; and every power and remedy given by this MORTGAGE to the CITY may be exercised from time to time and as often as may be deemed expedient to the CITY.

Section 23.7. Waiver of Extension, Appraisement or Stay Laws. To the extent permitted by law, the OWNER will not during the continuance of any Event of Default hereunder insist upon, or plead, or in any manner whatever claim or take any benefit or advantage of, any stay or extension law wherever enacted, now or at any time hereafter in force, which may affect the covenants and terms of performance of this MORTGAGE; nor claim, take or insist upon any benefit or advantage of any law now or thereafter in force providing for the valuation or appraisement of The Project or any part thereof, prior to any sale or sales thereof which may be made pursuant to any provisions herein contained, or pursuant to the decree, judgment or order of a court of competent jurisdiction, not after any such sale of sales; claim or exercise any right under any statute hereford any state or territory, or otherwise, to redeem the property so sold or any part thereof; and the OWNER hereby expressly waives all benefits or advantage of any such law or laws and covenants not to hinder, delay or impede the execution of any power herein granted or delegated to the CITY, but to suffer and permit the execution of every power as though no such law or laws had been made or enacted.

Section 23.8. Remedies Subject to Provisions of Law. All rights, remedies and powers provided by this Article may be exercised only to the extent that the exercise thereof does not violate any applicable provision of law in the premises, and all the provisions of this Article are intended to be subject to all applicable mandatory provisions of law which may be controlling in the premises and to be limited to the extent necessary so that they will not render this MORIGAGE invalid or unenforceable under the provisions of any applicable law.

Section 23.9. Remedies Under Uniform Commercial Code. In addition to any, other remedies provided for hereby or by law the CITY shall have the rights of a secured party and the OWNER shall have the rights of a debtor under the Uniform Commercial Code of Indiana, codified at Indiana Code 26-1 (or any successor code or statute) with respect to the personal property included in The Project upon the occurrence and continuance of an Event of Default hereunder, as defined in Section 5.1 hereof.
