2. Funds for Taxes and Insurance. 4. Charges; Liens. Borrower shall pay all taxes, assessments, charges, thies and impositions attributable to the Property which may attain priority over this Security Instrument; and leasehold payments or ground rents, if any. Borrower shall pay these obligations in the manner provided in paragraph 2, or if not paid in that manner, Borrower shall pay them on time directly to the person owed payment. 5. Hazard Insurance. This insurance shall be maintained in the amounts and for the periods that Lender requires: The insurance carrier providing the insurance shall be chosen by Borrower subject to Lender's approval which shall not be unreasonably withheld.

6. Preservation and Maintenance of Property; Leaseholds. Borrower shall not destroy, damage or substantially change the Property, allow the Property to deteriorate or commit waste. If this Security Instrument is on a leasehold, Borrower shall comply with the provisions of the lease, and if Borrower acquires fee title to the Property, the leasehold and fee title shall not merge unless Lender agrees to the merger in writing.

7. Protection of Lender's Rights in the Property; Mortgage Insurance. If Borrower fails to perform the covenants and agreements contained in this Security Instrument, or there is a legal proceeding that may significantly affect Lender's rights in the Property (such as a proceeding in bankruptcy, probate, for condemnation or to enforce laws or regulations), then Lender may do and pay for whatever is necessary to protect the value of the Property and Lender's rights in the Property. 14. Notices. Any notice to Borrower provided for in this Security Instrument shall be given by delivering it or by mailing it by first class mail unless applicable law recolless use of another method. 15. Governing Law; Severability. This Security Instrument shall be governed by federal law and the law of the jurisdiction in which the Property is located. In the event that any provision or clause of this Security Instrument or the Note conflicts with applicable law, such conflict shall not affect other provisions of this Security Instrument or the Note which can be given effect without the conflicting provision. To this end the provisions of this Security Instrument and the

Note are declared to be severable.

16. Borrower's Copy. Borrower shall be given one conformed copy of the Note and of this Security Instrument.

17. Transfer of the Property or a Beneficial Interest in Borrower. If all or any part of the Property or any interest in it is sold or transferred (or if a beneficial interest in Borrower is sold or transferred and Borrower is not a natural person) without Lender's prior written consent, Lender may, at its option, require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Security Instrument. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if exercise is prohibited by federal law as of the date of this Security Instrument.

If Lender exercises this option, Lender shall give Borrower notice of acceleration. The notice shall provide a period of not less than 30 days from the date the notice is delivered or mailed within which Borrower must pay all sums secured by this Security Instrument. If Borrower fails to pay these sums prior to the expiration of this period, Lender may invoke any

18. Borrower's Right to Reinstate. This Adjustable Rate Loan Rider ("Rider") is made this 1st day of February , 1992 and is incorporated into and shall be deemed to amend and supplement the Mortgage ("Security Instrument") of the same date given by the undersigned ("Borrower") to secure Borrower's Note to CITIZENS FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION ("Lender") of the same date ("Note") and covering the property described in the Security Instrument and which has the address of 6911 West 126th Avenue, Crown: Point, IN 46307

MODIFICATIONS. In addition to the covenants and agreements made in the Security Instrument, Borrower and Lender further covenant and agree as follows:

### A: INTEREST RATE AND MONTHLY PAYMENT CHANGES

The Note has an Initial Interest Rate of 6.40%. The Note interest rate may be increased or decreased on the first day of the month beginning on March 1. , 1995 and on that day of the month every twelve (12) months thereafter. Each date on which the interest rate may change will be called a "Change Date."

Changes in the interest rate will be pased on changes in an interest rate index.' The Index is the Monthly Average Vield on the United States Treasury Securities Adjusted to a Constant Maturity of the Near 1.

Before each Change Date, the Note Holder will calculate the new interest

The Note Holder will round the new interest rate to the nearest one-eighth of one percentage point.

The interest rate will not be changed by more than two (2) percentage points on any Change Date. The maximum interest rate ("Ceiling") charged will not be more than 12:40%. The Note Holder will adjust the new interest rate so that the change in the interest rate will not be more than those limits.

### B. LOAN CHARGES

It could be that the loan secured by the Security Instrument is subject to law which sets maximum loan charges and that law is interpreted so that the interest or other loan charges collected or to be collected in connection with the loan would exceed permitted limits. If there is a transfer of the Property subject to paragraph 17 of the Security Instrument, Lender may require (1) an increase in the current Note interest rate, or (2) an increase in (or removal of) the limit on the amount of any one interest rate change the maximum interest charged, and the minimum interest rate charged (if there is a limit), or (3) a different Index, or (4) the payment of Loan Fees, or all of these, as a condition of Lender's waiving the option to accelerate provided in paragraph 17.
