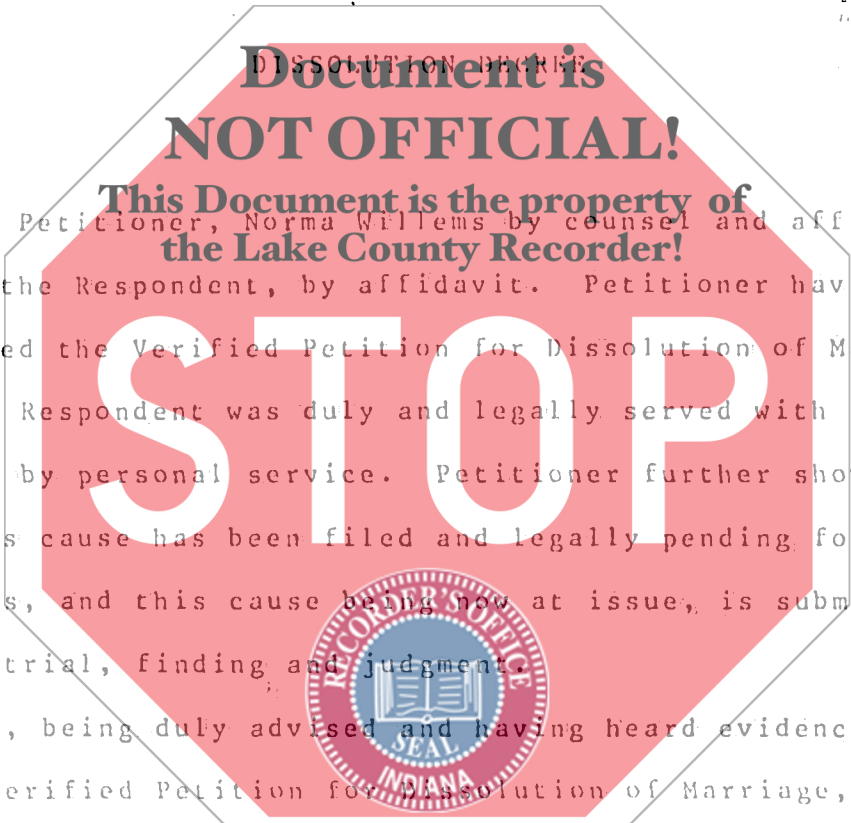

Comes now Petitioner, Norma Willems by counsel and affidavit,
and comes now the Respondent, by affidavit. Petitioner having
previously filed the Verified Petition for Dissolution of Marriage
now shows that Respondent was duly and legally served with summons on
November, 1991 by personal service. Petitioner further shows the
Court that this cause has been filed and legally pending for more than
sixty (60) days, and this cause being now at issue, is submitted to

ordered and directed by the Court to carry out the terms and provisions
of that agreement.
