

Last Will and Testament of Harold Eugene Roy

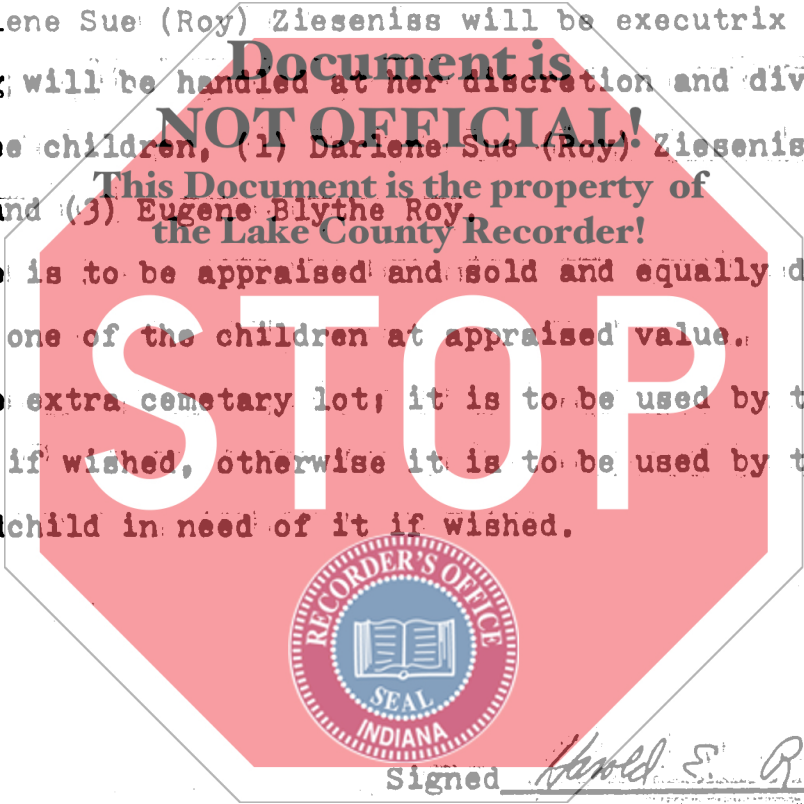
I, Harold E. Roy, of Ross Township, Lake County, Indiana, hereby make and publish my last will and testament.
