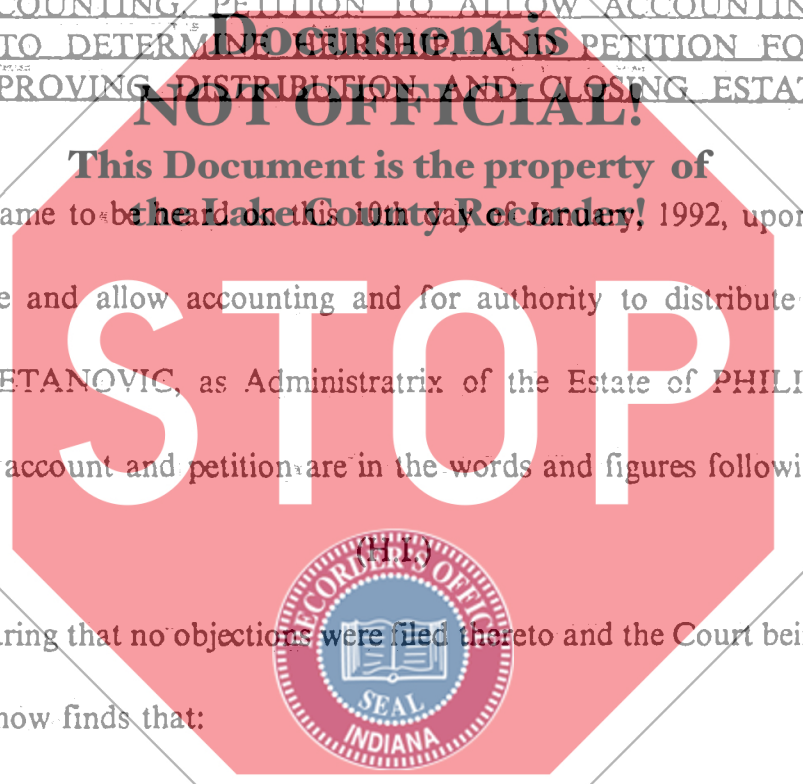

ORDER APPROVING ADMINISTRATRIX'S FINAL REPORT AND  
ACCOUNTING PETITION TO ALLOW ACCOUNTING  
PETITION TO DETERMINE HEIRS, AND PETITION FOR ORDER  
APPROVING DISTRIBUTION AND CLOSING ESTATE



This cause came to be heard on this 10th day of January, 1992, upon final account, petition to settle and allow accounting and for authority to distribute estate filed by EVELYN KAPETANOVIC, as Administratrix of the Estate of PHILIP C. PISKOL, deceased, which account and petition are in the words and figures following, to-wit:

And it appearing that no objections were filed thereto and the Court being fully advised in the premises now finds that:

1. Due notices of the filing of said account and petition and of the hearing on the same were given to all persons interested in said estate and the same are now properly before the Court for final action thereon.

2. PHILIP C. PISKOL died intestate, a resident of the County of Lake, State of Indiana, on the 11th day of December, 1984, and said Administratrix was issued Letters of

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Administration on the 21st day of December, 1984, and since that date she has continued to serve in such capacity.

3. The matters and things stated in said account and petition are true and that said Administratrix has accounted for all of the assets in this estate coming into her hands.

4. More than five (5) months have elapsed since the date of the first published notice to the heirs and creditors of said decedent; all claims filed against said estate have been paid and discharged; neither said decedent nor his Administratrix was an employer of labor within the meaning of that term as used in the Indiana Employment Security Act; all estate taxes, inheritance taxes and gross income taxes, if any, assessed in said estate have been paid.

5. The decedent died leaving the following heirs at law pursuant to the provisions of Indiana Code, I.C. 29-1-2-1: a sister, EVELYN KAPETANOVIC and a brother, MYLES PISKOL, and that said decedent died unmarried, leaving no children, nor descendants of any predeceased child or children.

6. The decedent owned a certain piece of real estate located at 1935 Calumet Avenue, Whiting, Indiana in the County of Lake, State of Indiana, more particularly described as follows:

Lot twenty-six (26) in Block Twelve (12) in Smith and Bader's 2nd West Park Addition to Hammond as the same appears of record in Plat Book 15, page 9 in the Recorder's Office of Lake County, Indiana,

and that upon the death of said decedent, said real estate vested by the laws of intestacy in his sister, EVELYN KAPETANOVIC and his brother MYLES PISKOL, as tenants in common.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court as follows:

1. Said Final Report and Account of said Administratrix is hereby in all things approved, settled and confirmed.

2. The distribution of the balance of the property remaining in said Administratrix's hands for distribution should be made pursuant to the distribution set forth in the final accounting and is hereby in all things approved.

3. Pursuant to the laws of intestacy the following described real estate, to-wit:

Lot twenty-six (26) in Block Twelve (12) in Smith and Bader's 2nd West Park Addition to Hammond as the same appears of record in Plat Book 15, page 9 in the Recorder's Office of Lake County, Indiana,

is vested in EVELYN KAPETANOVIC and MYLES PISKOL as tenants in common.

And said Administratrix is hereby directed to procure and record in the office of the Recorder of Lake County, being the county in which said real estate is located, a certified copy of this Final Decree.

4. Said Administratrix is hereby directed to distribute and pay over the balance of the estate in her hands for distribution in equal amounts to herself and her brother MYLES PISKOL.

5. Said Administratrix is hereby directed to file her Supplemental Report showing that she has complied with the terms of this order and that said Administratrix has in all things carried out the provisions of this final decree. All of which is ordered this 10th day of January, 1992.
