**AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT OF REQUEST  
BY OWNER TO CAUSE RECORDER TO CERTIFY  
THAT MORTGAGE AS FULLY PAID AND  
SATISFIED BY LAPSE OF TIME  
PURSUANT TO I.C.32-8-4-1, ET SEQ.**

Mary C. Skurka, being first duly sworn upon her oath, says:

1. That Clement J. Skurka and Mary C. Skurka, husband and wife, were the owners of certain real estate located in Lake County, Indiana legally described as:

Lot No. 16, and Lot No. 17, (except the south 10 feet thereof) in Block No. 2, as marked and laid down on the recorded plat of Parkside Addition, Hammond, in Lake County, Indiana, as the same appears of record in Plat Book 16, Page 25, in the Recorder's Office of Lake County, Indiana.

2. That Clement J. Skurka and Mary C. Skurka did assume a mortgage created from John Kennedy and Bernice B. Kennedy, his wife, to Great Lakes Mortgage Corporation, an Illinois corporation, dated September 6, 1951 and recorded September 13, 1951 in the Office of the Recorder of Lake County, Indiana, in Mortgage Record 876 page 556, as Document No. 562300.

3. That said mortgage was assigned to City National Bank and Trust Company of Chicago, a National Banking Association, by assignment, dated March 24, 1952 and recorded April 7, 1952, in Mortgage Record 899 page 72, as Document No. 601033.

4. That said mortgage was further assigned to Metropolitan Life Insurance Company, a New York corporation, by assignment, dated March 25, 1952 and recorded April 7, 1952, in Mortgage Record 899 page 73, as Document No. 601034.

5. That said mortgage was granted in favor of John Kennedy and Bernice B. Kennedy, his wife, to secure a note in the sum of Nine Thousand Two Hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$9,200.00) payable at the rate of Fifty-five and 75/100 Dollars (\$55.75) per month commencing January 1, 1952, and each month thereafter on said even

date until September 1, 1971, when said indebtedness is paid in full.

6. That Clement J. Skurka died on January 12, 1974, leaving Mary C. Skurka surviving him.

7. That Mary C. Skurka is no longer a resident of the State of Indiana.

8. By virtue of lapse of time as authorized by I.C. 32-8-4-1, I.C. 32-8-4-2, and I.C. 32-8-4-3, said note and mortgage should be deemed fully paid and satisfied in that September 1, 1971 would be the latest date that said mortgage would be enforceable.

9. That this affidavit is made pursuant to statute and is made and provided to cause the Recorder of Lake County, Indiana to certify that said mortgage is fully paid and satisfied by lapse of time and that the subject real estate whose legal and common address appear above and as described in said mortgage, is release for lien thereof.

10. That the averments contained herein are true. Further affiant saith not.
