This cause came to be heard on the 1st day of November, 1991, upon the final account, petition to settle and all account and for authority to distribute estate filed by Val Dawson, as personal representative of the estate of Reanna Nash, deceased, which account and petition are in the words and figures following, to-wit:

And it appearing that no objections were filed thereto and the Court being fully advised in the premises, now finds that:

1. Due notices of the filing of said account and petition and of the hearing on the same were given to all persons interested in said estate, and the same are now properly before the Court for final action thereon.

2. That Reanna Nash, died testate, a resident of the County of Lake, State of Indiana, on the 22nd day of September, 1988, and her Last Will and Testament was duly admitted to probate before this Court on the 22nd day of April, 1989, and this Court appointed said Rudolph Val Dawson as successor personal representative of the Last Will and Testament of the decedent, and said personal representative was issued Letters Testamentary on the 22nd day of April, 1989, and since that date he has continued to serve in such capacity.

3. That the matters and things stated in said account and petition are true and that said personal representative has accounted for all of the assets in this estate coming into his hands.

More than five (5) months have elapsed since the date of the first published notice to legatees, devisees, and creditors of said decedent; all claims filed against said estate have been paid and discharged; neither said decedent nor her personal representative were employers of labor within the meaning of that term as used in the Indiana Employment Security Act; all estate taxes, inheritance taxes and gross income taxes, if any, assessed in said estate have been paid.

5. The following persons are the sole legatees and devisees under the decedent's Last Will and Testament: Fred Nash, husband, 100%, and that all assets and property of this estate remaining after payment of decedent's debts and expenses of administration has been distributed to the above-named person, as evidenced by their receipt of voucher which is attached hereto and made a part of this accounting.

6. That the decedent owned a certain piece of real estate located at 3830 Deal Street, in the County of Lake, State of Indiana, more particularly described as follows:

and that the decedent devised said real estate in Article III of her Last Will and Testament to Fred Nash.

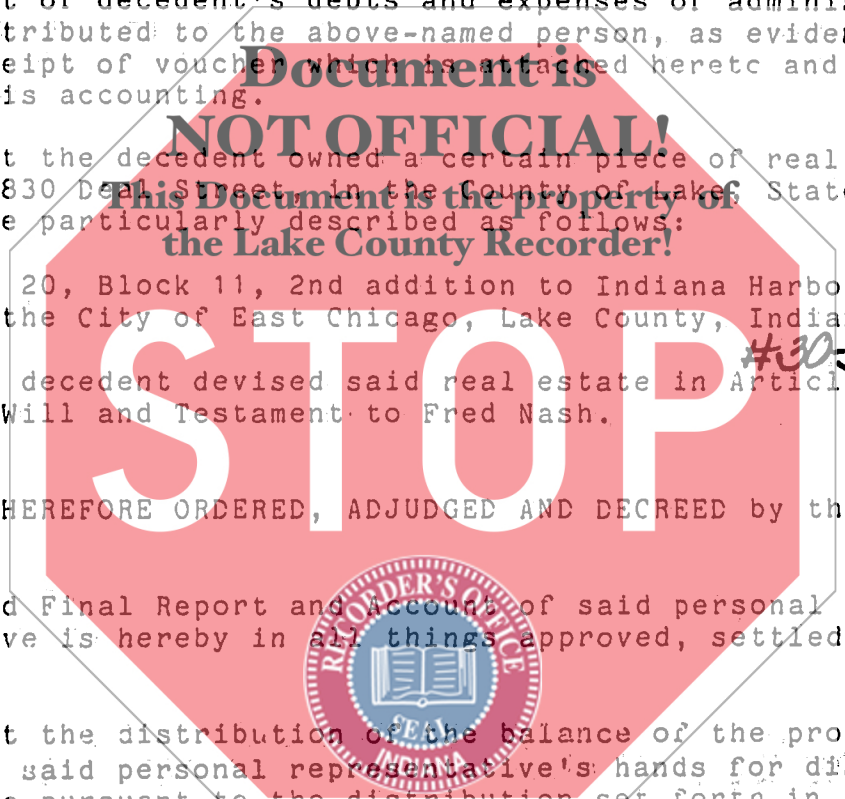
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court as follows:

1. Said Final Report and Account of said personal representative is hereby in all things approved, settled and confirmed.

2. That the distribution of the balance of the property remaining in said personal representative's hands for distribution has been made pursuant to the distribution set forth in the final accounting as prescribed under the Last Will and Testament of said decedent and is hereby in all things approved.

3. That pursuant to the decedent's Last Will and Testament the following described real estate, to-wit: is hereby vested in Fred Nash pursuant to the provisions of the decedent's Last Will and Testament.

And that said personal representative is hereby directed to procure and record in the office of the Recorder of Lake County, being the county in which said real estate is located, a certified copy of this Final Decree.



4. Said personal representative having made distribution of all assets and property and having attached vouchers evidencing said distribution to said legatees and devisees, said distribution is hereby approved and confirmed.

5. Said personal representative is hereby directed to file his Supplement Report showing that he has complied with the terms of this order and that said personal representative has in all things carried out the provisions of this final decree, or hereby released and discharged from any further liability or responsibility as said personal representative of the estate of Reanna Nash. All of which is ordered this 1st day of November, 1991.
