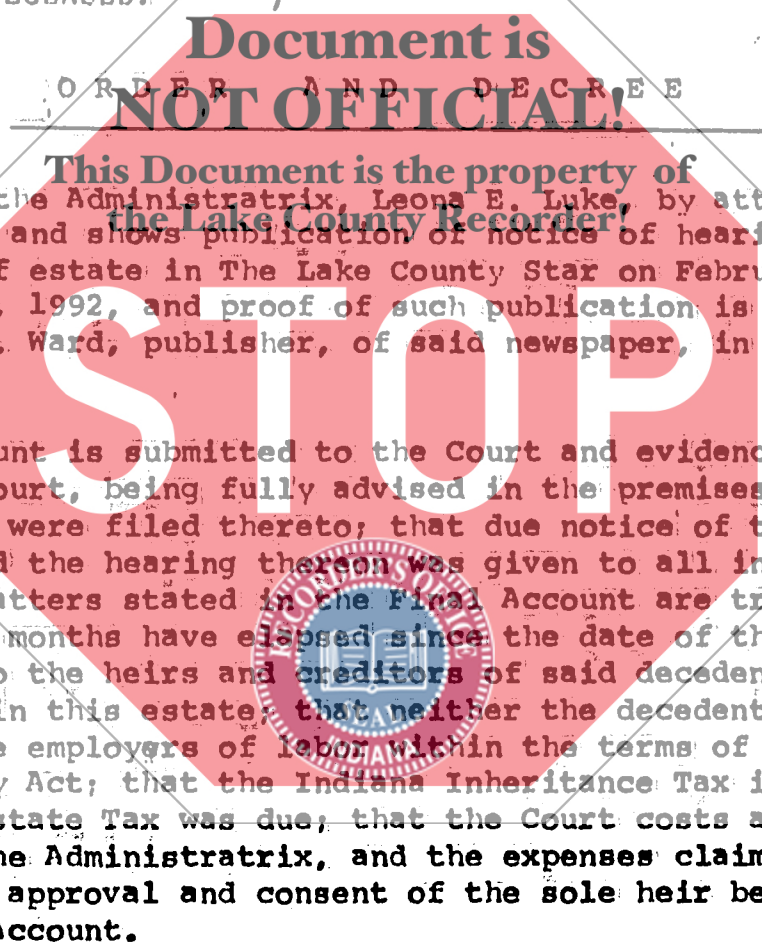

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS CONSIDERED, ORDERED AND DECREED BY THE COURT:


1. That said Final Account is, in all things, approved, settled and confirmed;
