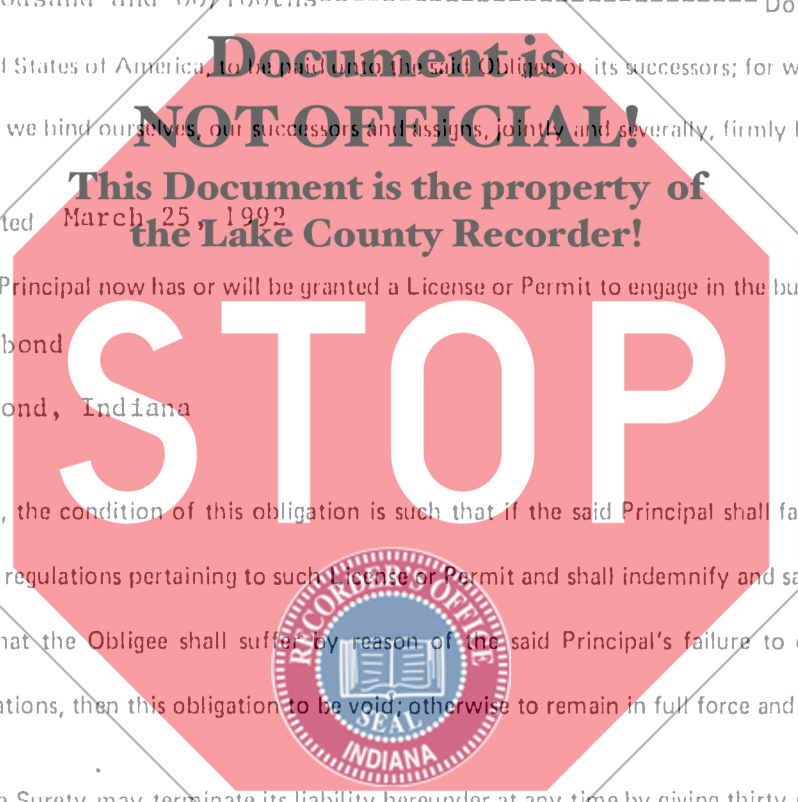
NOW, THEREFORE, the condition of this obligation is such that if the said Principal shall faithfully comply with all

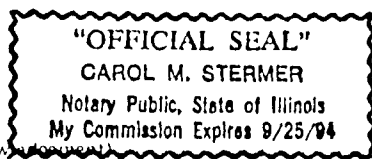
