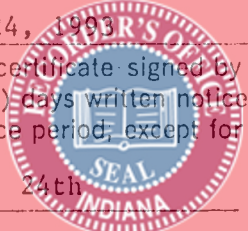
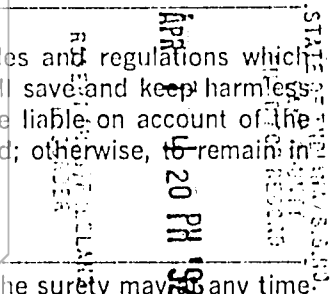

Any such power, so executed and sealed and certified by certificate so executed and sealed, shall, with respect to any bond or undertaking to which it is attached, continue to be valid and binding on the Corporation.

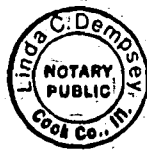
