**ORDER APPROVING EXECUTOR'S FINAL REPORT,  
PETITION TO SETTLE AND ALLOW ACCOUNTING, AND  
PETITION FOR ORDER APPROVING DISTRIBUTION AND CLOSING ESTATE**

This cause came to be heard on the 11th day of August, 1989, upon the final account, petition to settle and allow account and for authority to distribute estate filed by RICHARD C. BRENNAN, as Executor of the Estate of Drusilla Brennan, deceased, which account and petition are in the following words and figures, to-wit: (H.I.)

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And it appearing that no objections were filed thereto and the Court being fully advised in the premises now finds that:

1. The waivers of Notice and consent of Richard C. Brennan were filed with the Final Report, and due notices of the filing of said account and petition and of the hearing on the same were given to all other persons interested in said estate, and the same are now properly before the Court for final action thereon.

2. Drusilla Brennan died testate, a resident of the County of Lake, State of Indiana, on the 19th day of July, 1978, and her Last Will and Testament was duly admitted to probate before this Court on the 15th day of August, 1978, and this Court appointed said RICHARD C. BRENNAN, as Executor of the Last Will and Testament of the decedent, and said Executor was issued Letters of Testamentary on the 15th day of August, 1978, to him and he has continued to serve in such capacity.

3. The matters and things stated in said account and petition are true, and that said Executor has accounted for all the assets in said estate coming into his hands.

4. More than five (5) months have elapsed since the date of first published notice to legatees, devisees and creditors of said decedent; all claims filed against said estate have been paid and discharged; neither said decedent nor her Executor were employers of labor within the meaning of that term as used in the Indiana Employment Security Act; all estate taxes, inheritance taxes and gross income taxes, if any, assessed in said estate have been paid.

5. The following persons are the sole residuary legatees and devisees under the decedent's Last Will and Testament:

- (a) Richard C. Brennan 100%

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and he has filed his written waiver of notice and consent to

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accounting which are in the following words and figures: (H.I.)

6. The decedent owned a certain piece of real estate located at 6942 Alabama Avenue, Hammond, Lake County, Indiana, more particularly described as follows:

The decedent owned a certain piece of real estate located at 9216 Pottowattomi, Gary, Lake County, Indiana, more particularly described as follows:

Lot Thirty-three (33) in Block Five (5) as marked and laid down on the recorded plat of Young's Dunelands, a subdivision of the North 64.37 acres of Government Lots 3 and 4, in Section 33, Township 37 North, Range 7 West of the 2nd P.M., in Lake County, Indiana, as the same appears of record in Plat Book 21, Page 44, in the Office of the Recorder of Lake County, Indiana, and commonly known as 9216 Pottowattomi, Gary, Lake County, Indiana,

and that real estate vested in Richard C. Brennan, upon the decedent's death as part of the residuary estate.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court as follows:

1. Said Final Report and Account of said Executor is hereby in all things approved, settled and confirmed as to assets contained therein.

2. The distribution of the balance of the property set out in said accounting in said Executor's hands for distribution has been made pursuant to the distribution set forth in the final accounting as prescribed under the Last Will and Testament of said decedent and is hereby in all things approved.

3. Pursuant to the decedent's Last Will and Testament the following described real estate, to-wit:

Lot Three (3), Block Two (2) as marked and laid down on the recorded plat of Strange & Rumsey's Addition in the City of Hammond in Lake County, Indiana as per plat thereof, recorded in Plat Book 22, Page 1, in the Office of the Recorder of Lake County, Indiana, and commonly known as 6942 Alabama Avenue, Hammond, Indiana.

Lot Thirty-three (33) in Block Five (5) as marked and laid down on the recorded plat of Young's Dunelands, a subdivision of the North 64.37 acres of Government Lots 3 and 4, in

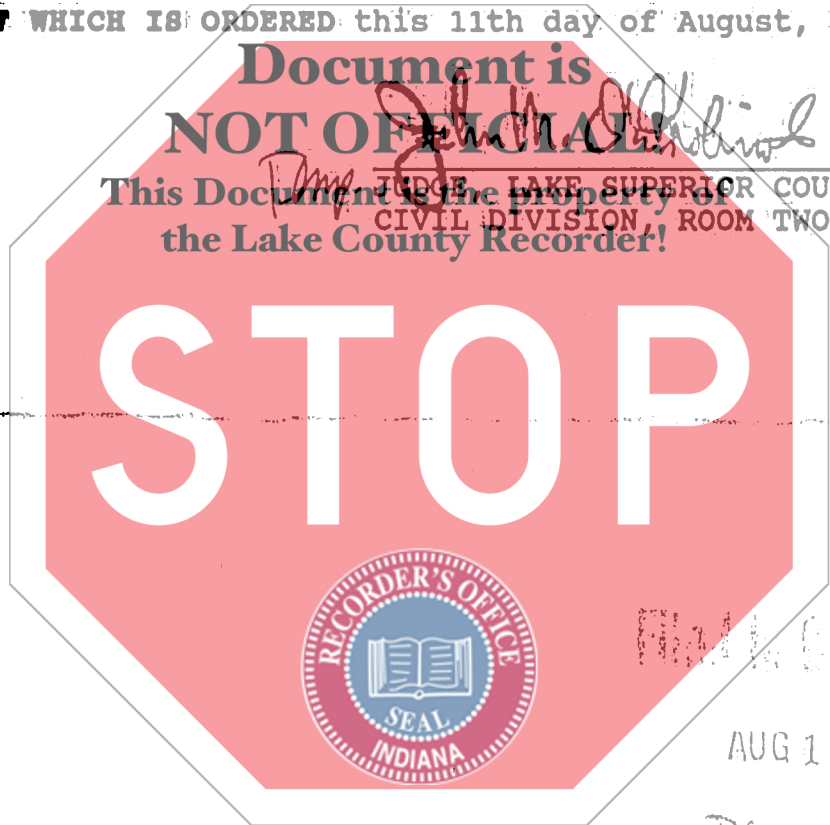
