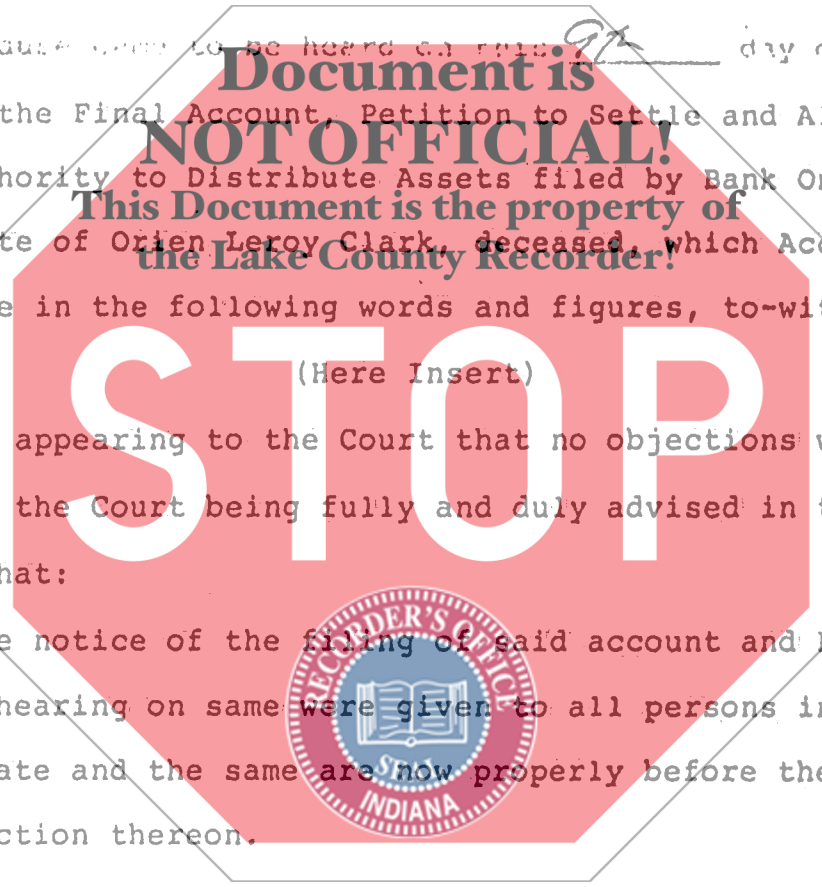

And it appearing to the Court that no objections were filed thereto and the Court being fully and duly advised in the premises now finds that:

1. Due notice of the filing of said account and Petition and of the hearing on same were given to all persons interested in said estate and the same are now properly before the Court for final action thereon.

2. That Orient Leroy Clark, died testate, a resident of Lake County, Indiana, on January 6, 1984, and said Executor was issued Letters Testamentary on August 1, 1984, and since that date has continued to serve in such capacity.

3. That the matters and things stated in said account and Petition are true and that said Executor has accounted for all the assets in this estate coming into his hands.

That more than five (5) months have lapsed since the date of the first published notice to the heirs and creditors of said decedent; all claims filed against said estate have been paid and discharged; neither said decedent nor his Executor was an Employer of Labor within meaning of that term as used in the Indiana Employment Security Act; all estate taxes, inheritance taxes and gross income taxes, if any, assessed in said estate have been paid.

2. That after the payment of incidental administrative expenses, the estate shall be distributed in full to Raymond Clark which estate includes real estate legally described as follows, to-wit:

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and the Executor is directed to transfer said real estate by filing a certified copy of this Order with Lake County Recorder.

3. That said Executor is hereby directed to file his Supplemental Report showing compliance with the terms of this Order and that the Executor has in all things carried out the provisions of this final decree on or before: 7-14-92.
