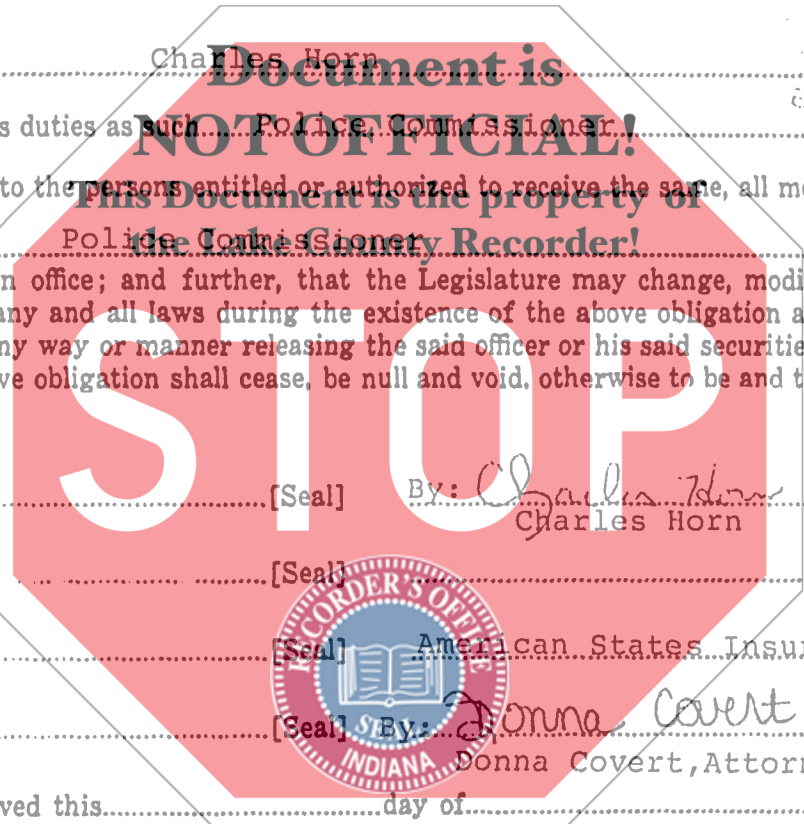


KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, .....

 Legislature, without in any way or manner releasing the said officer or his said securities on said bond; then,  
 and in that case, the above obligation shall cease, be null and void, otherwise to be and to remain in full force  
 and virtue in law.
