AFFIDAVIT OF SURVIVORSHIP

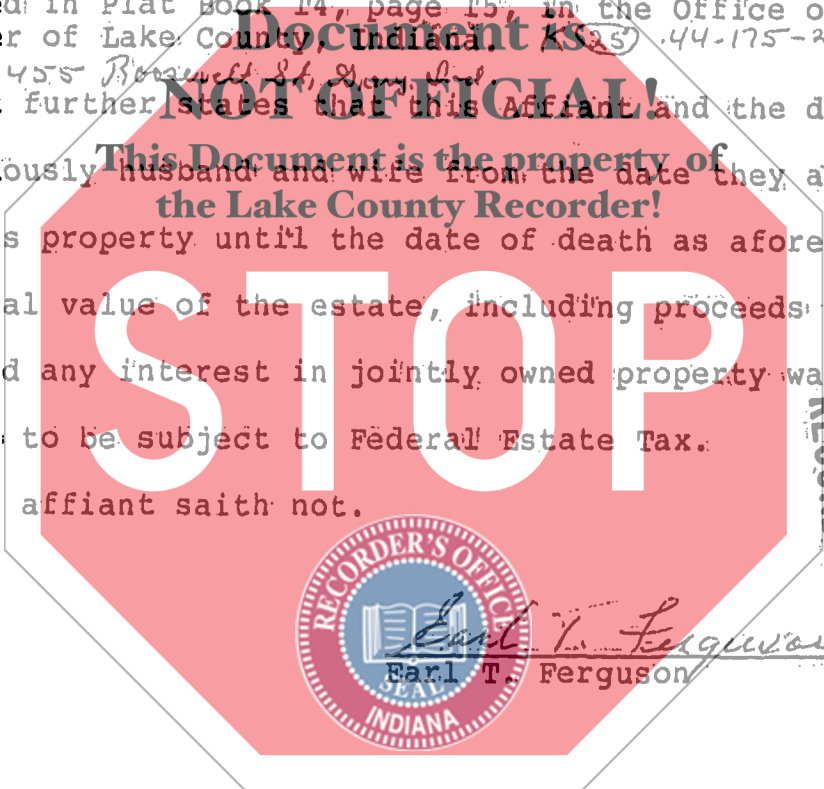
Earl T. Ferguson, being first duly sworn upon his oath, states:
