GENERAL DURABLE POWER OF ATTORNEY

6. To have access to any and all safe deposit boxes in my name and to open, inspect, inventory, place items in or remove from, and close said safe deposit boxes;
7. To bargain for, contract concerning, buy, sell, encumber and in any way and manner, deal with personal property of any kind or nature and to apply or make use of my property for my support and the support of those persons to whom I owe an obligation or support;
8. To execute instruments to effect the transfer of title to any motor vehicle owned by me;
9. To maintain, purchase, surrender, acquire, assign, pledge, make claims under, borrow against, partially or fully liquidate, change beneficiaries, designate insured, and generally deal in all forms of insurance and claims thereon;
10. To purchase, sell, mortgage, convey and lease any interest in real estate, wherever located, of which I may be owner now or hereafter (if this provision is applicable, this instrument must be recorded);

SECTION TWO: EFFECTIVE DATE.

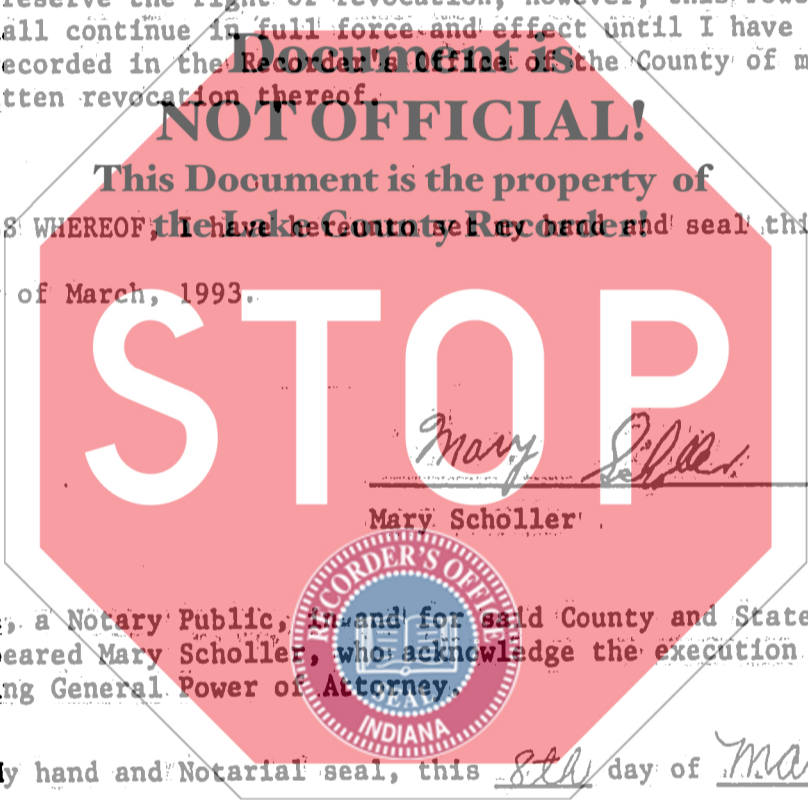
This Power of Attorney shall become effective on the 5 day of March, 1993, and shall not be affected by my subsequent disability or incompetence.
