Parcel 1: A part of the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 23, Township 33 North, Range 9 West of the 2nd P.M., described as: Commencing at the center point of said Section 23 and running thence South 88 degrees and 43 minutes East along the South line of the Northeast quarter of said Section 23, 147.4 feet to a stake; thence North 720 feet on a line of survey made on June 12, 1905, by the County Surveyor of said Lands, to a stake; thence West 147.4 feet on the line of the same survey to a stake, thence South 720 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning, in Lake County, Indiana.
