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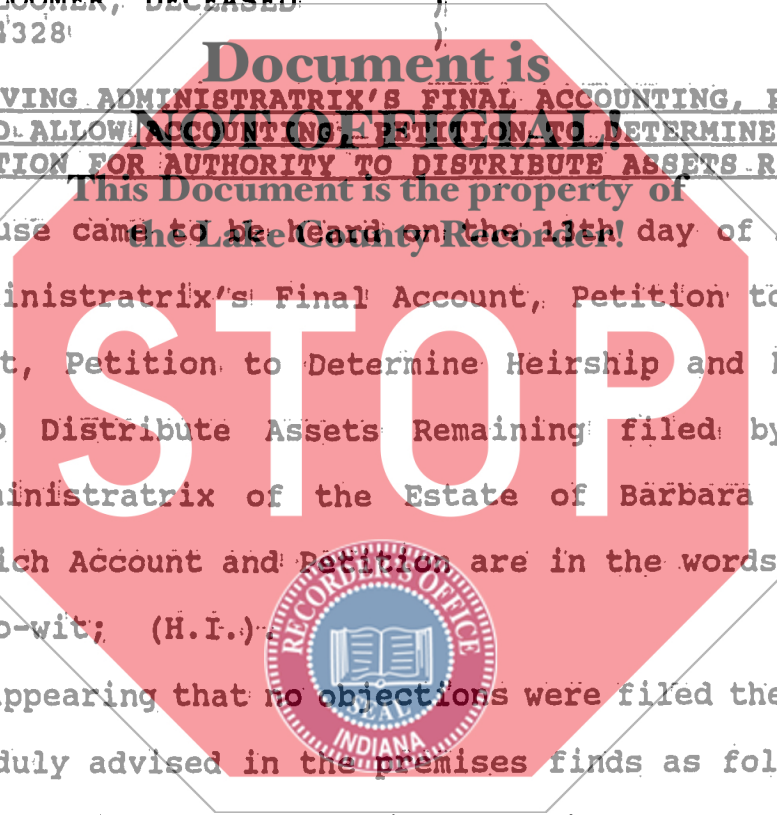
This cause came to be heard on the 13th day of April, 1993,

upon the Administratrix's Final Account, Petition to Settle and Allow Account, Petition to Determine Heirship and Petition for Authority to Distribute Assets Remaining filed by Lorrie A. Frisbie, Administratrix of the Estate of Barbara J. Bloomer, Deceased, which Account and Petition are in the words and figures following, to-wit; (H.I.)

And it appearing that no objections were filed thereto and the Court being duly advised in the premises finds as follows:

1. Due notices of the filing of said Account and Petition and of the hearing on the same were given to all interested persons in said Estate and said notice was published in the Merrillville Herald Newspaper as evidenced by the Affidavit of Publication submitted to the Court.

2. That Barbara J. Bloomer died intestate domiciled in Lake County, Indiana on the 11th day of July, 1992, and upon a Petition, Lorrie A. Frisbie was duly appointed Administratrix and Letters of

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Administration were issued to her on the 15th day of September, 1992, and since that date Lorrie A. Frisbie has continued to serve in such capacity.

3. That the matters and things stated in said Account and Petition are true and said Administratrix has accounted for all the assets in said Estate coming into his hands.

4. More than five (5) months have elapsed since the date of the first published notice to heirs and creditors of the decedent. No claims have been filed against said Estate and all bills and obligations of the decedent and of the Estate have been paid and discharged with the exception of property transfer costs and the Administratrix's commission. Neither said decedent nor said Administratrix was an employer of labor within the meaning of that term as used in the Indiana Employment Security Act. All Indiana Inheritance Tax has been paid. No Federal Estate Tax was assessed in said Estate.

7. The Administratrix has waived a commission. William B. Davis has filed a Petition for Attorney's fees in the sum of \$3,000.00 which has been previously approved by separate Court Order.

1. Said Final Report and Account of said Administratrix is hereby in all things approved, settled and confirmed.

After the payment of all expenses related to distribution, the distribution of the balance of the property remaining in said Administratrix's hands for distribution should be made in accord with the Petition for Heirship contained in the Administratrix's Final Account and the Administratrix is authorized and directed to make distribution to said heirs as follows, to-wit:

is hereby vested 4/6th in Lorrie A. Frisbie, 1/6th in Michael G. Bloomer, and 1/6th in Charles Bloomer, as tenants in common.

5. Said Administratrix is further directed to file her Supplemental Report showing that she has complied with the terms of this Order and that said Administratrix has in all things carried out the provisions of this Final Decree.
