This matter came to be heard this 20th day of February, 1981 on petitioner's Petition for Dissolution in the words and figures following: (HI) and the petitioner having shown notice to respondent by publication of summons, the date of first publication the 17th day of December, 1980, and having filed his Proof of Publication reflecting the publication thereof, and the Court having heard evidence and being duly advised in the premises now finds that:

1. Parties were married on or about February 21, 1958.
2. Parties were separated October 13, 1980, and have not since lived together as husband and wife.
3. Respondent left petitioner.
4. Respondent's whereabouts, both at the time of the filing of this Petition for Dissolution and today at the hearing, are to petitioner unknown; that petitioner's search was diligent.
5. Respondent took with her all of parties' household furniture together with a 1973 Pontiac titled to petitioner and daughter, Ramona Navarro.
6. There were four (4) children born of this marriage, Raoul Jr., Ramona, Anthony, and Scott, born September 22, 1958, March 29, 1960, October 26, 1962, and August 31, 1963, respectively, three of whom are emancipated; that Scott was withdrawn from school October 10, 1980, and is presumeably with the respondent; that petitioner does not know the whereabouts of Scott.

7. Parties are the owners of the following parcels of real estate as tenants by the entireties:

Parcel I

The Northern 101 feet of the Southern 909 feet of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter and the Northern 101 feet of the Southern 909 feet of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter all in Section 15, Township 27 North, Range 5 West consisting of about six (6) acres, in the County of Eau Claire, State of Wisconsin.

Parcel II

Lot 8, Block II, Beverly Highlands as shown in Plat Book 19, Page 11, in Lake County, Indiana.

respondent's interest therein should be divested and vested in petitioner.

8. Parties are the owners of the motor vehicles following:
 - a. 1973 Lincoln titled to petitioner.
 - b. 1973 Buick titled to petitioner and respondent.
 - c. 1973 Pontiac titled to petitioner and daughter Ramona Navarro

respondent's interest in parties' 1973 Buick should be divested and vested in petitioner.

9. There has been an irretrievably breakdown in the marriage.

10. Petitioner has been a resident of the county of Lake and state of Indiana for a period in excess of three (3) and six (6) months respectively.

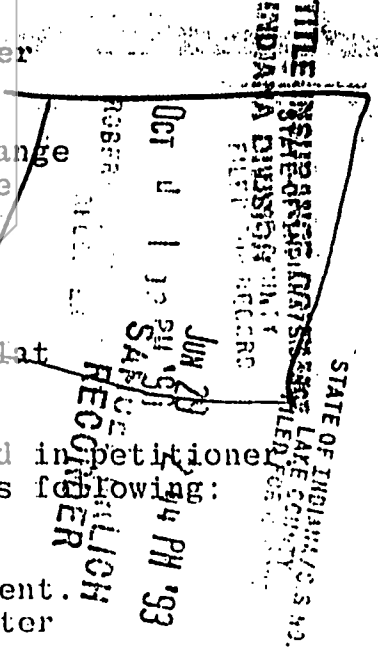
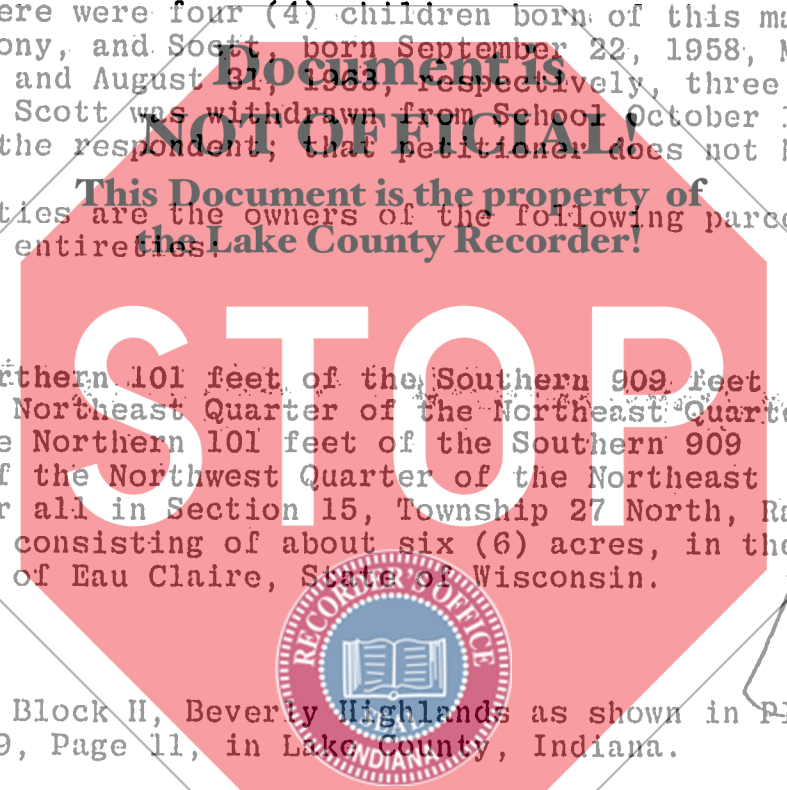
11. This matter is properly before the Court and petitioner's Petition For Dissolution should be granted.
