
The cause came to be heard on the 3rd day of November, 1993, on
the Co-Personal Representative's Final Account, Petition to Settle and
Allow Account, Petition to Determine Heirship, and Petition for
the Lake County Recorder's Authority to Distribute Estate Assets, all of which are in the following
words and figures, to-wit: (H. I.)

It appearing that no objections were filed and the Court, being
fully and duly advised in the premises, now finds as follows:

1. That due notice of the filing of said account and petition's
and hearing on same was given to the decedent's devisees and all persons
interested in said estate as evidenced by the Publisher's Af-
fidavit filed herein by the Hobart Gazette, a public daily newspaper
of general circulation, printed and published in the City of Hobart,
Indiana, and notices to the purported devisees of the decedent issued
by the Clerk of the Lake Superior Court.

2. That the matters and things stated in said petitions and ac-
count are true and that the co-personal representatives have accounted
for all assets of the estate coming into their hands.

3. That more than five (5) months have elapsed since the date of
the first published notice to the devisees and creditors herein; that

no claims have been filed against the estate; that neither the decedent nor her co-personal representatives were employers of labor within the meaning of that term as used in the Indiana Employment Security Act. The inheritance tax due the State of Indiana has been paid as evidenced by the duly countersigned Receipt of the Treasurer of Lake County, Indiana. There are no Federal estate taxes due the United States nor income taxes due either the State of Indiana or the United States.

4. That the decedent died the owner of the following described real estate located in Lake County, Indiana, and commonly known as 7505 Tapper Avenue, Hammond, Indiana:

Lot 1, in Block 1, in Wisteria in the City of Hammond, as per plat thereof, recorded in Plat Book 29, page 4, in the Office of the Recorder of Lake County, Indiana.

5. That the decedent died testate and pursuant to the terms of Item IV of her Last Will and Testament dated August 6, 1984, the aforesaid real estate was devised as follows:

"I give to my son RICKEY A. BALLOU, the use of my residence situated at 7505 Tapper Avenue, Hammond, Lake County, Indiana, for so long as he continues to personally reside there. At the point that he no longer resides at the residence, it shall be sold and the proceeds divided between my children, per stirpes."

and the rest and residue of the estate assets is to be distributed equally to her following named children: HAROLD V. BALLOU, ILENE C. BACH, BETTY L. POTEET, RICKEY A. BALLOU, and SUSAN K. BALLOU f/k/a SUSAN K. LORENZ.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court as follows:

1. That said final account and petitions are, in all things, approved.
2. That the real estate described as follows shall be held by RICKEY A. BALLOU for use as his residence for so long as he continues to personally reside there. At the point that he no longer resides at the residence, it shall be sold and the proceeds divided between HAROLD V. BALLOU, ILENE C. BACH, BETTY L. POTEET, RICKEY A. BALLOU, and SUSAN K. BALLOU f/k/a SUSAN K. LORENZ, per stirpes.

Lot 1, in Block 1, in Wisteria in the City of Hammond, as per plat thereof, recorded in Plat Book 29, page 4, in the Office of the Recorder of Lake County, Indiana.



Said supplemental account shall be filed on or before

Dec 7, 1993.
