BORROWER COVENANTS that Borrower is lawfully seised of the estate hereby conveyed and has the right to mortgage. grant and convey the Property and that the Property is unencumbered, except for encumbrances of record-Borrower warrants and will defend generally the title to the Property against all claims and demands, subject to any encumbrances of record:

This Security Instrument combines uniform covenants for national use and non-uniform covenants with limited variations by jurisdiction to constitute a uniform security instrument covering real property.

UNIFORM COVENANTS. Borrower and Lender covenant and agree as follows:

- 1. Payment of Principal and Interest; Přepayment and Late Charges. Borrower shall promptly pay when due the principal of and interest on the debt evidenced by the Note and any prepayment and late charges due under the Note.
- 2. Funds for Taxes and Insurance. The Funds shall be held in an institution whose deposits are insured by a federal agency, instrumentality, or entity (including Bender, if Lender is such artinstitution) or in any frederall tone Louis Bunk. Lender shall apply the Funds to pay the Escrow Items. 5. Hazard or Property Insurance. Borrower shall keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the Property insured against loss by fire, hazards included within the term "extended coverage" and any other hazards, including floods or flooding, for which Lender requires insurance.
