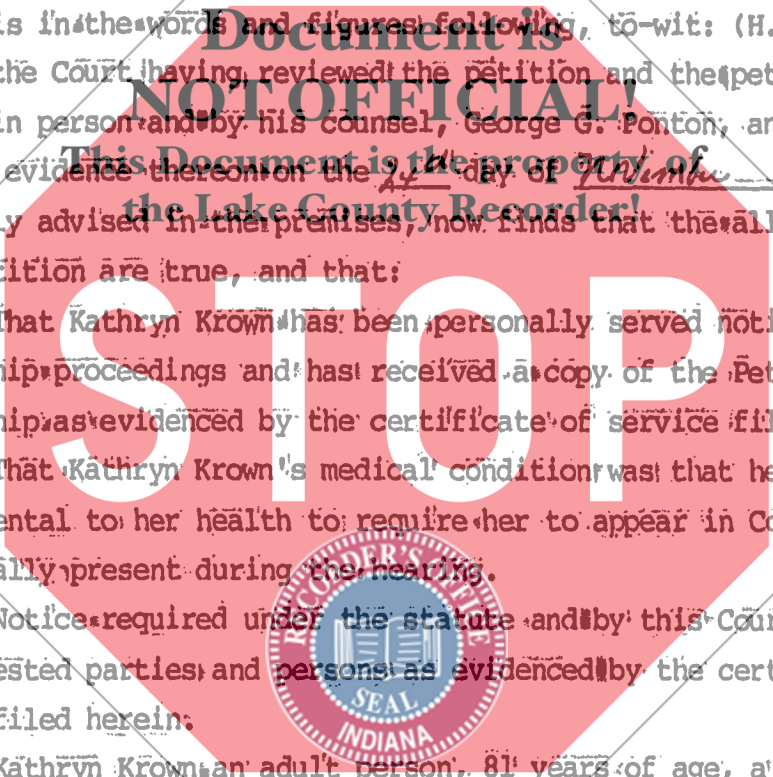

Comes now Greg Cochran, who having filed his verified petition for the appointment of a guardian over the person and estate of Kathryn Krown, which petition is in the words and figures following, to-wit: (H.I.)

And the Court having reviewed the petition and the petitioner having appeared in person and by his counsel, George G. Ponton, and the Court having heard the evidence thereon on the 24 day of November, 1992, and being fully advised in the premises, now finds that the allegations contained in the petition are true, and that:

1. That Kathryn Krown has been personally served notice of these guardianship proceedings and has received a copy of the Petition for Guardianship as evidenced by the certificate of service filed herein.
2. That Kathryn Krown's medical condition was that her physician deemed it detrimental to her health to require her to appear in Court to testify and be physically present during the hearing.
3. Notice required under the statute and by this Court has been sent to all interested parties and persons as evidenced by the certified mail receipts filed herein.
4. Kathryn Krown an adult person, 81 years of age, a resident of White County, Indiana, residing at Monticello Health Care, Monticello, Indiana 47960, is incapable of handling her person and property because of physical and mental infirmities and is hereby found to be an incapacitated person under Indiana law.
5. Kathryn Krown is in need of a guardian because of her incapacity, and it is in the best interests of Kathryn Krown that a guardian be appointed over her person and estate.
6. George G. Ponton is a suitable person to serve as guardian and is fully qualified and willing to assume the duties and responsibilities of the guardianship.

7. All of the requirements for the appointment of a guardian as set forth in the Indiana Code have been satisfied, and George G. Ponton is entitled to be guardian of the person and estate of Kathryn Krown and is so appointed without any limitations as to his duties, responsibilities, or powers as set out in I.C. 29-3-8-1, I.C. 29-3-8-2, and I.C. 29-3-8-4.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that:

1. Kathryn Krown by reason of her incapacity is unable to care for her person and estate and is therefore adjudicated to be an incapacitated person and guardian over her person and estate is necessary.

2. George G. Ponton is the most qualified and suitable person available to serve as guardian and is hereby appointed as the guardian of the person and estate of Kathryn Krown.

3. George G. Ponton shall serve as guardian upon taking an oath before the Clerk of this Court.

4. Upon taking such an oath, the Clerk of this Court is directed to issue Letters of Guardianship of the Person and Estate to George G. Ponton without any limitations as the guardian is authorized to exercise all powers granted a guardian over the person or estate of an adult incapacitated person as set forth in I.C. 29-3-8-1, I.C. 29-3-8-2, and I.C. 29-3-8-4.
